Monthly Emergency Population Release Report - September 2005

During September, there were 17 days when emergency population releases occurred, totaling 467 early releases; a 14% decrease from August. Of those releases, 456 were unsentenced and 11 were sentenced while 444 were males and 23 were females. Total releases for the first nine months of this calendar year have reached 3,765; a 46% increase over 2004's first nine months of 2,579 releases. Listed below are the crime descriptions of those released in September, and the number of occurrences for each.
