

## Multnomah County Sheriff's Office

### Monthly Emergency Population Release Report - December 2005

December ended with 81 emergency population releases occurring on 6 days during the month; a 180% decrease from November's 227 releases and more than a 568% decrease from August's high of 541 releases. This dramatic decrease is most likely attributed to the opening of 57 beds on November 1<sup>st</sup> funded by the City of Portland and the Board approved 114 beds opened on December 9<sup>th</sup>. These additional beds bring the Jail Capacity up to 1690 beds. All 81 releases in December were males; 71 were unsentenced and 10 were sentenced. Total releases for 2005 reached 4,520; a 33.1% increase over 2004's yearly total of 3,395 releases. Listed below are the crime descriptions of those released in December, and the number of occurrences for each.
