

## Multnomah County Sheriff's Office

### Monthly Emergency Population Release Report - November 2005

November reported 227 emergency population releases occurring on 11 days during the month; a 116% decrease from this summer's high of 491 in July. This drastic decrease could be the result of the increase to Jail Capacity, up to 1576, due to the addition of the 57 Portland beds at MCIJ effective November 1<sup>st</sup>. Of those releases, all 227 were unsentenced and all were males. Total releases for this calendar year so far have reached 4,505; a 32.7% increase over 2004's yearly total of 3,395 releases. Listed below are the crime descriptions of those released in October, and the number of occurrences for each.
