Monthly Emergency Population Release Report - January 2006

Emergency population releases during January totaled 168; occurring on 9 days during the month. This is an increase of 75 releases from December, however, this is a 138% decrease from January 2005's total of 371 releases. All 168 releases during January were unsentenced; 156 were males and 12 were females. MCDC's capacity increased to 676 after the completion of the electronic remodel; while MCCF, (The Farm) was decommissioned on January 27th. Overall jail capacity stayed at 1690 beds in January. Listed below are the crime descriptions of those released in January, and the number of occurrences for each.
