Monthly Emergency Population Release Report - May 2006

May 2006 reported 247 Emergency Population Releases occurring on 13 days during the month; a 25% drop from April's 309 releases. This May's total is 68% lower than May 2005's total of 414 emergency releases. Of these 247 releases, 194 were males and 53 were females; all of them were unsentenced. Early releases of Traffic crimes slightly increased during May while early releases of Drug, Property and Behavioral crimes decreased. During the month, one individual released was of a Person crime. May's highest score released was 68; average release score was 35. The highest release score during May of 2005 was 99; 31 points higher than this May. Jail capacity remained at 1,690 beds for May; 111 beds more than May of 2005 (1,579 beds). Listed below are the crime descriptions of those released in May, and the number of occurrences for each.
