**Monthly Emergency Population Release Report
August 2006**

Emergency Population Releases during August totaled 26, occurring on 3 days during the month; a decrease of 86% from July's releases of 197 and a 95% decrease from August 2005's total of 541 releases. All of the 26 early releases during August were unsentenced; 11 were males and 15 were females. These 26 early releases were booked for Behavioral, Drug and Property crimes; there were no early releases for person or traffic crimes. The highest early release score during August was 49; 45% lower than July's highest early release score of 89. In 2005, the highest early release score for August was 98; 50% higher than this year. The average early release score for this August was 30; approximately a 28% decrease from July's average of 41 and last year's August average of 43. Jail Capacity this August remained at 1,690 beds, compared to 1,546 beds in August 2005. During this month a policy change occurred due to a legislative change to the definition of forced release which limits forced releases to pre-trial persons. Until further notice, Multnomah County will no longer be releasing convicted persons through emergency population release. Listed below are the crime descriptions of those released in August, and the number of occurrences for each.
