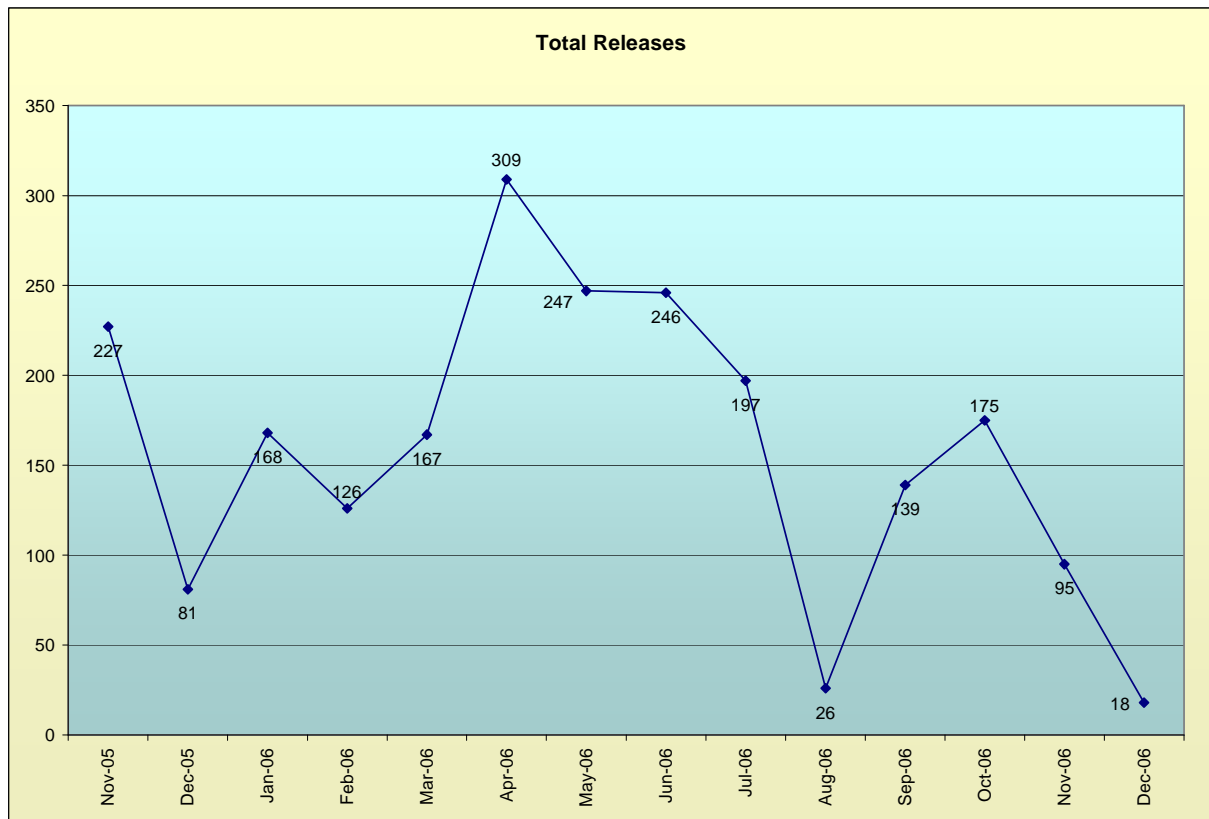
**Monthly Emergency Population Release Report
December 2006**

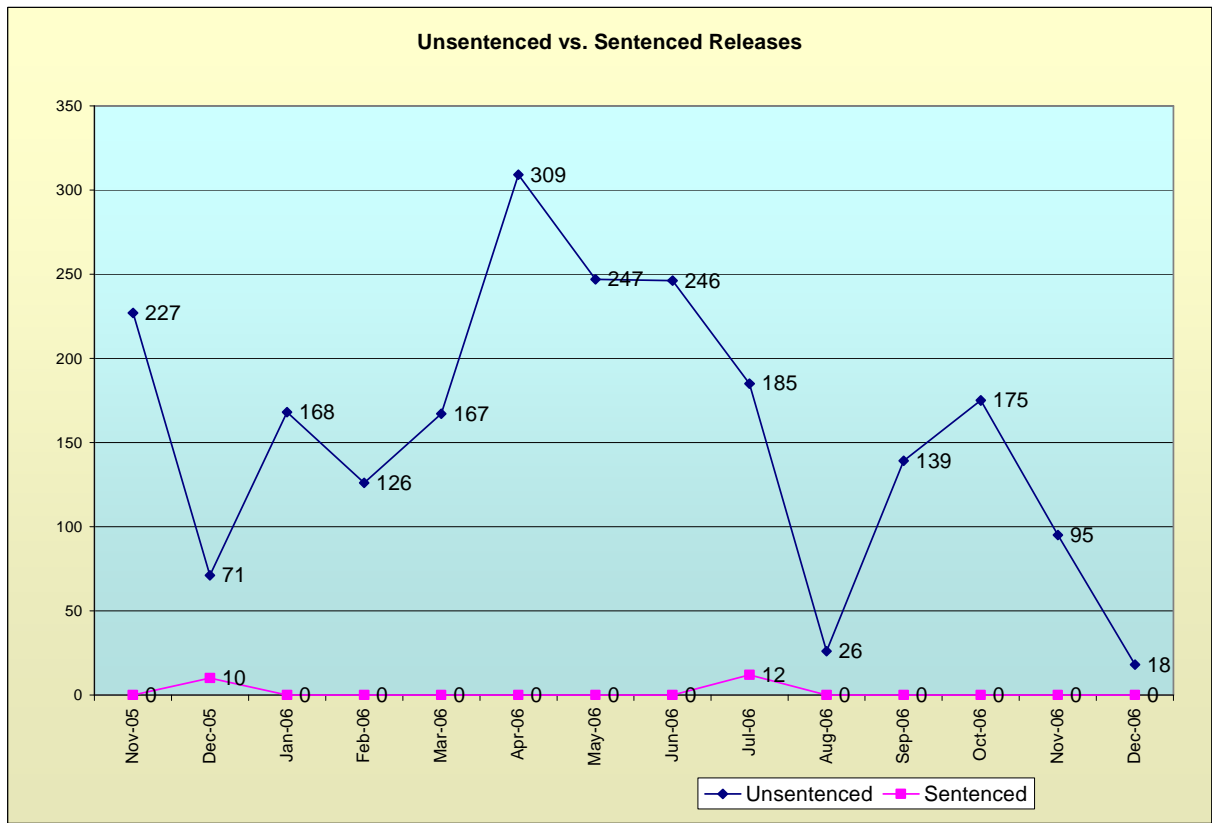
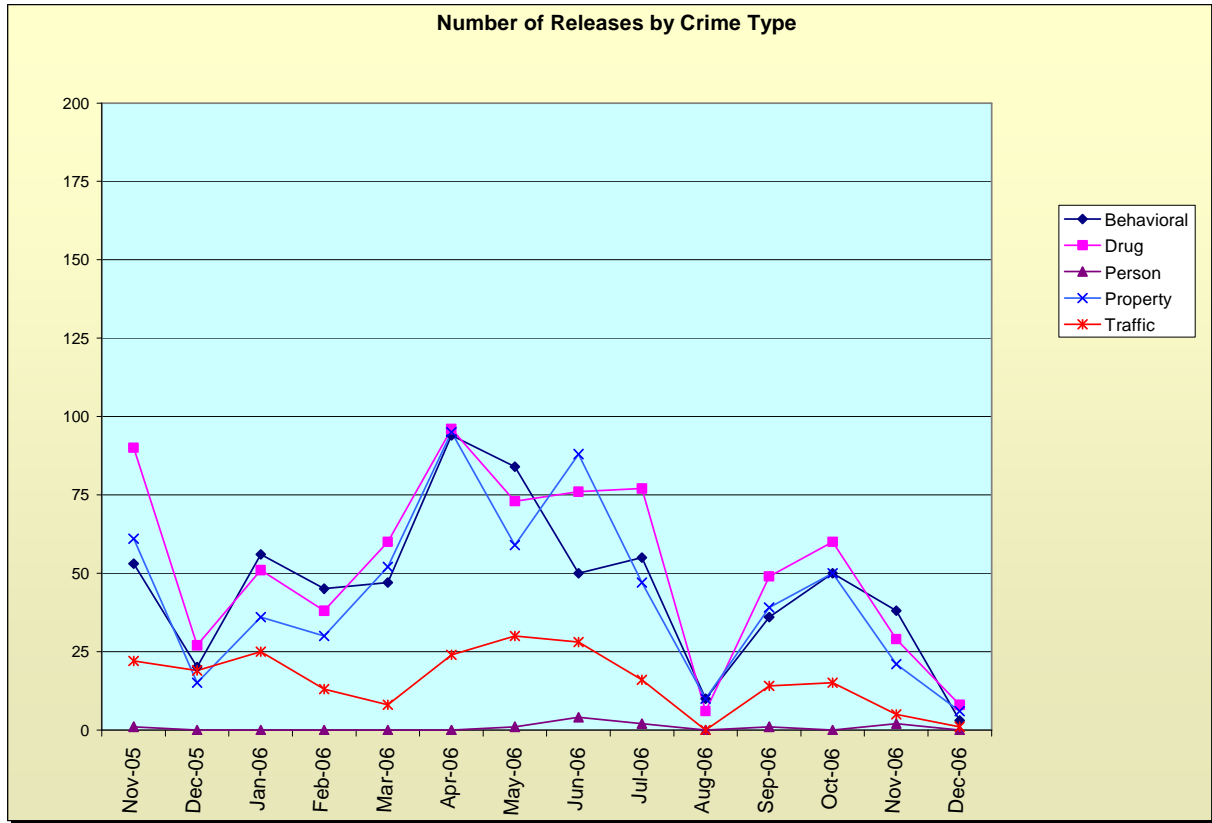
December reported one day during the month when emergency population releases occurred, totaling 18; an 81% decrease from November's total of 95 and a 77.8% decrease from one year ago when December's releases totaled 81. All of December's early releases were unsentenced males. The highest score for those released early in December was 39; down 74.3% from last month's highest score of 152 and down 76.6% from a year ago when the high score released was 77. The average score of those released in December was 25; a 51% decrease from November and a 30% decrease from December 2005. On December 9, 2005 an additional 114 beds opened at MCIJ, bringing total jail capacity to 1690 beds. Listed below are the crime descriptions of those released in December, and the number of occurrences for each.

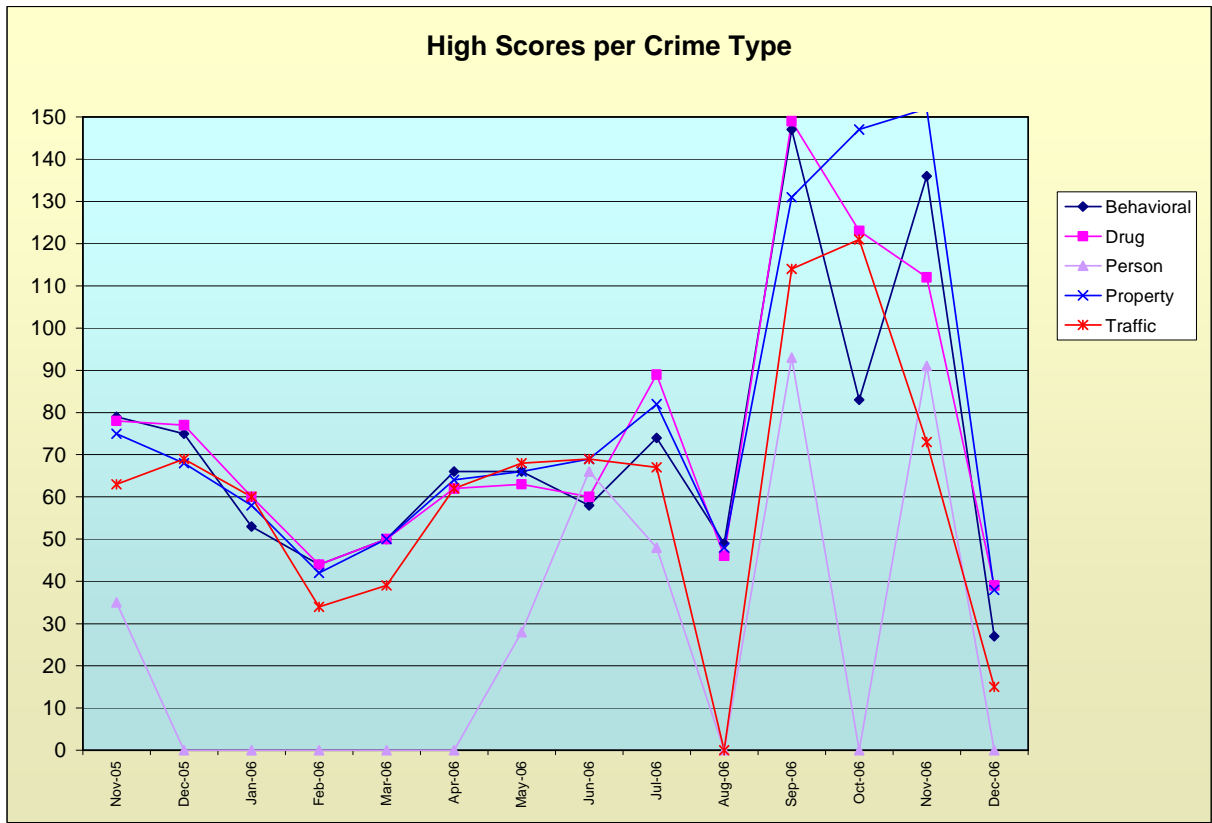
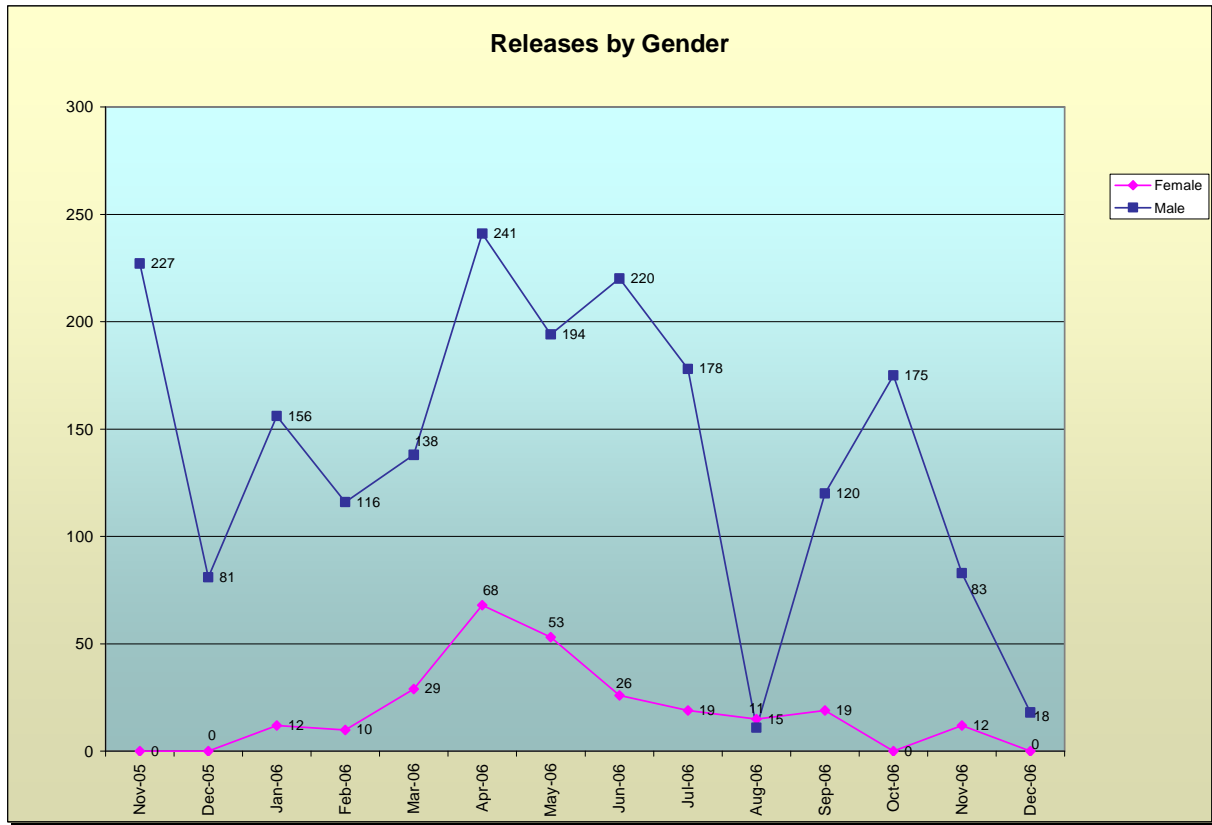
