## Monthly Emergency Population Release Report November 2007

There were a total of 23 unsentenced individuals, all female, released early during November. This is a small increase from October's zero early releases and a 75% decrease from October 2006 when the Emergency Population Releases totaled 95. The charges of those released early were related to Behavioral, Drug and Property crime types. Highest score of the individuals released early was 70 during November; a 54% decrease from a year ago when the high score of those released early in November was 152. Average score for the early releases in November was 36; 30% lower than last year when the average score was 52. Listed below are the crime descriptions of those released early in November, and the number of occurrences for each.
