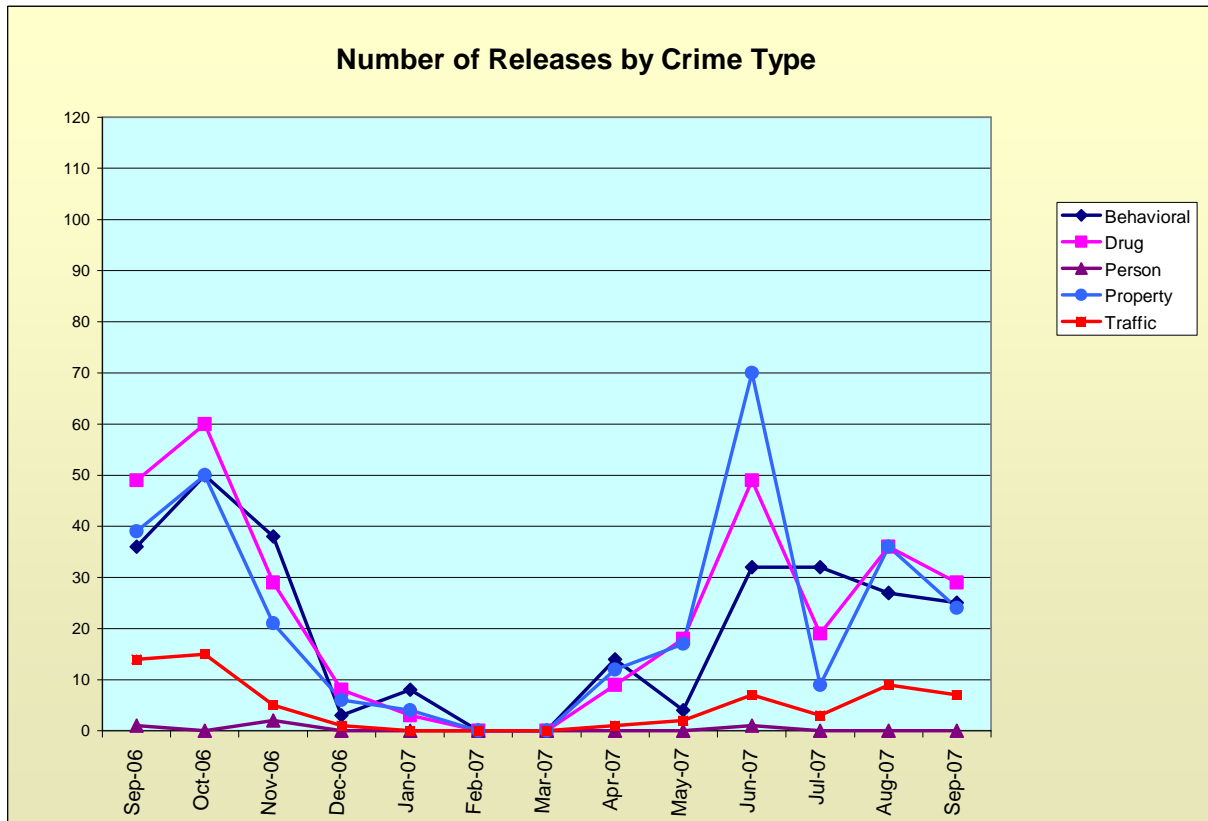
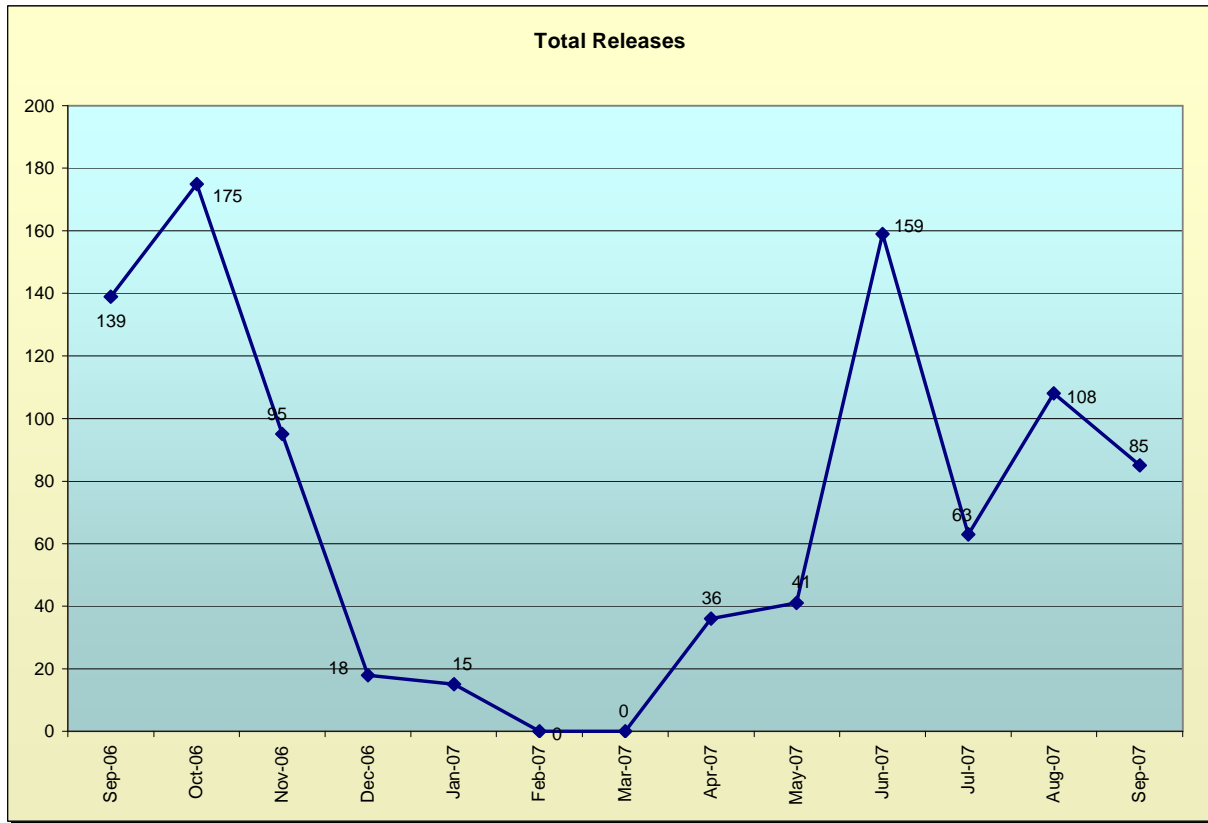
Monthly Emergency Population Release Report September 2007

There was a total of 85 Emergency Population Releases which occurred on 10 days during September. This is a 21% decrease from the August total of 108 and it's a 38% decrease from a year ago when the September total was 139. All 85 early releases during September were males; no females were released early. High score for September Emergency Population Releases was 128; this is virtually the same as August's high score of 131, and it's 21% lower than a year ago when the high score was 149. September's average score of those released early was 44. This is a 22% decrease from August's average score of 57 and a 27% decrease from September 2006 when the average score was 61. Listed below are the crime descriptions of those released in August, and the number of occurrences for each.

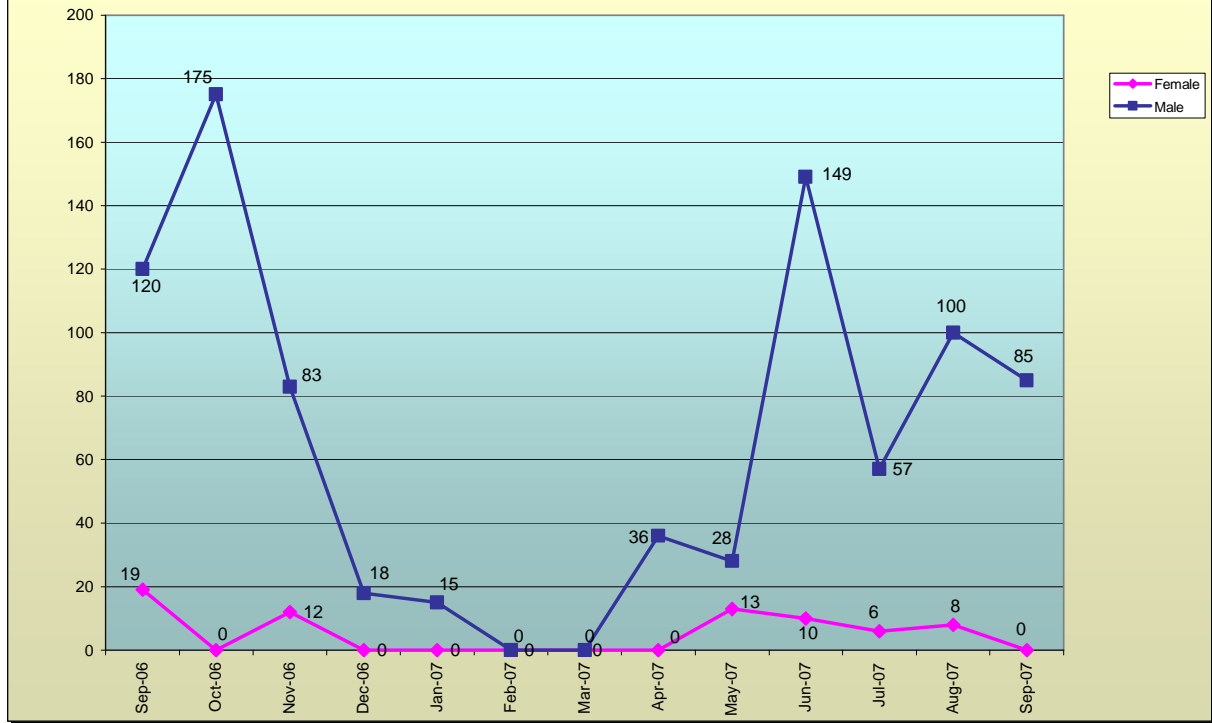
