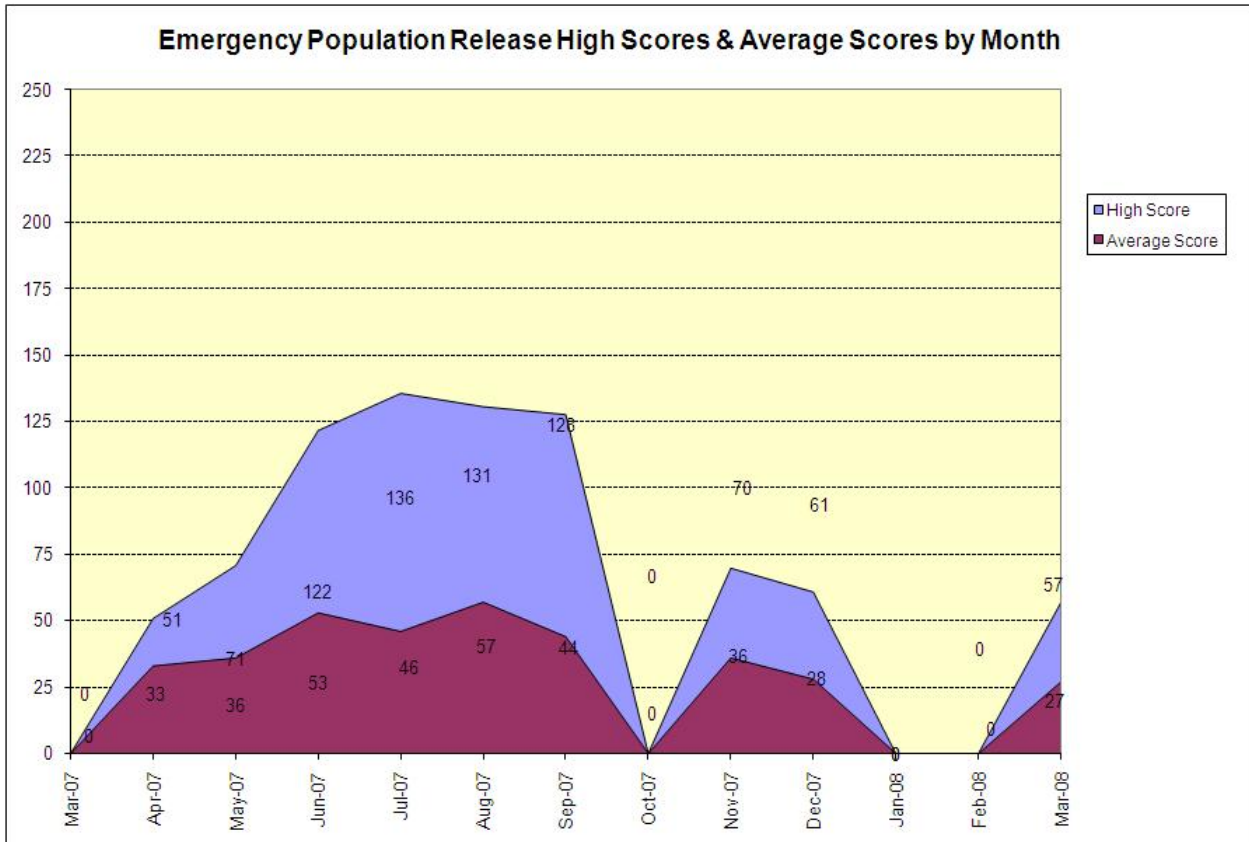
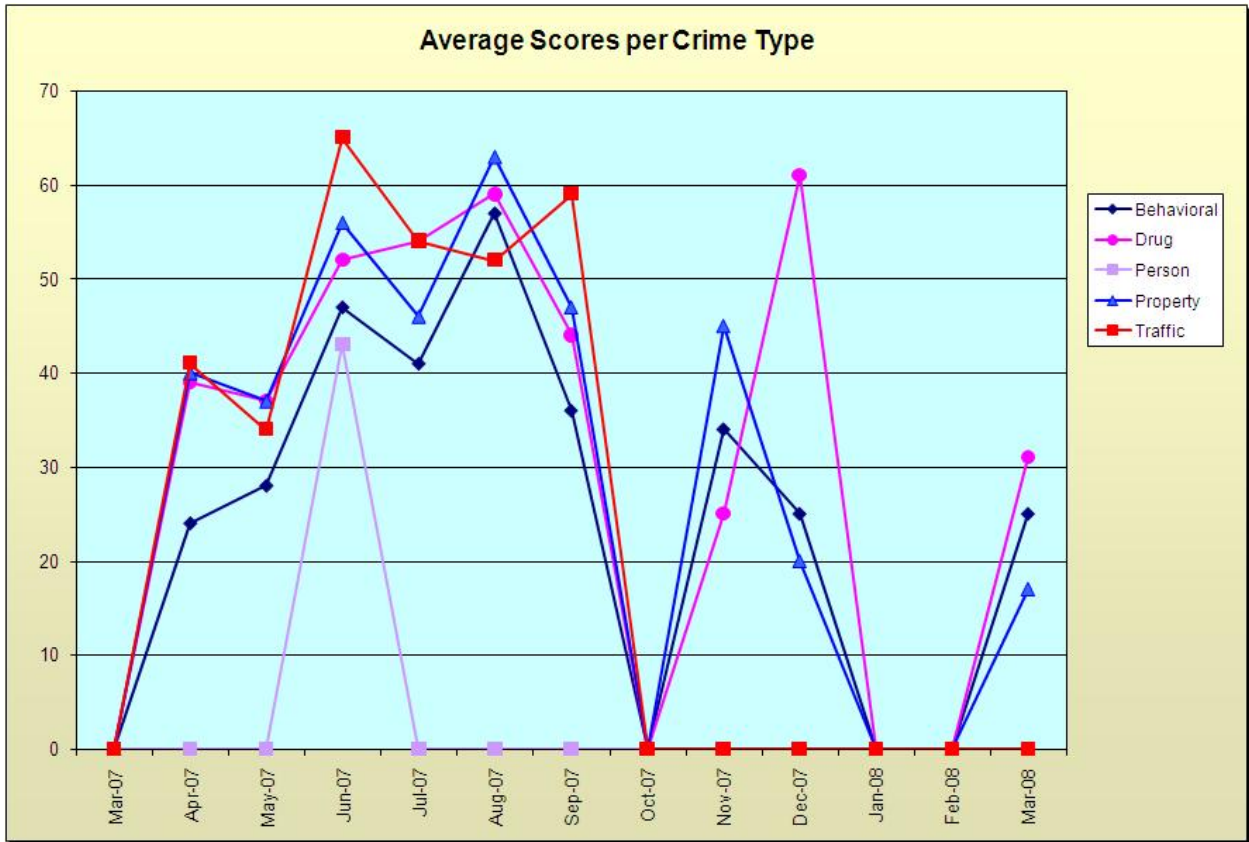
Monthly Emergency Population Release Report March 2008

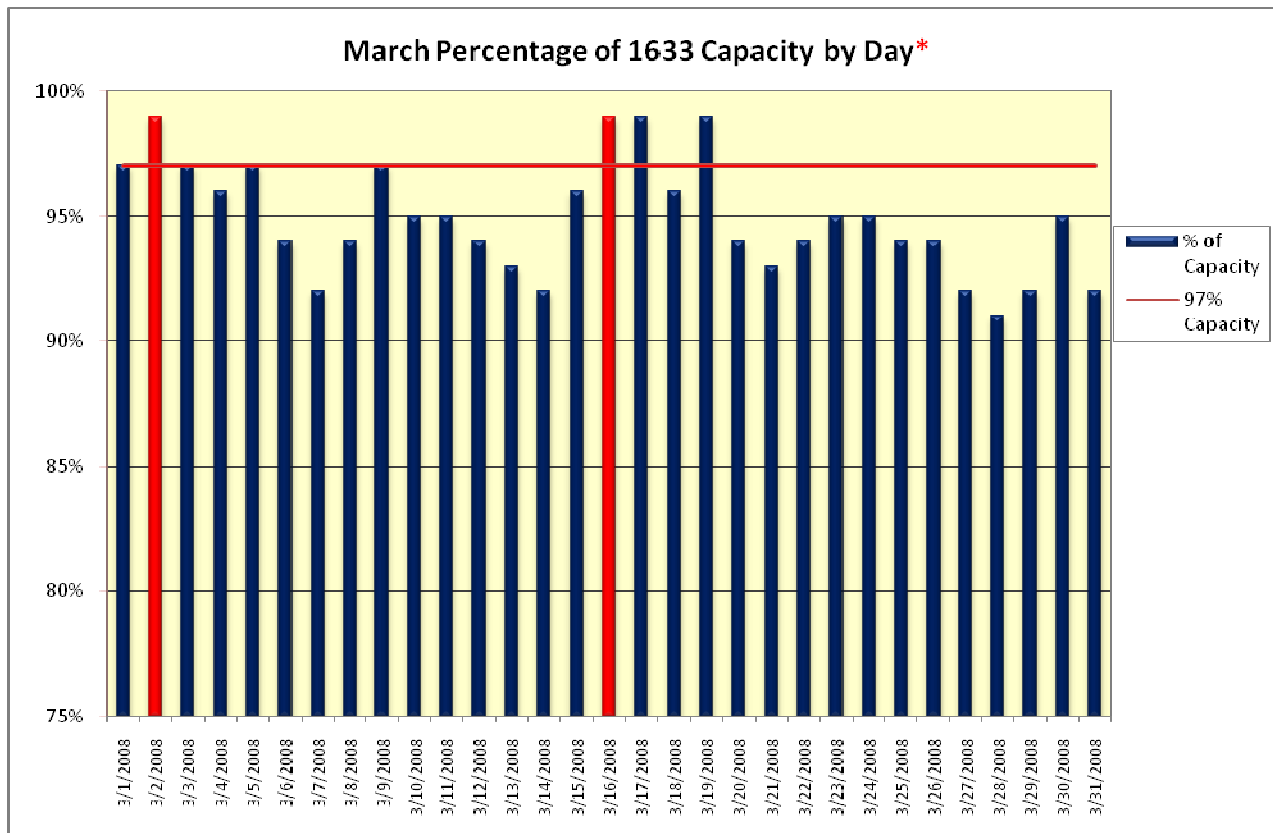
There were a total of 15 unsentenced individuals (10 males and 5 females) released in March 2008. Capacity exceeded emergency release status four times in March, however emergency population releases occurred on only two of those days. The last month that saw an emergency population release was December 2007, when a total of 9 unsentenced inmates were released. The highest score among March releases was 57, with an average score of 27. This is much lower than in the summer months of 2007, when the highest scores among those released were over 100 and group averages hovered around 50. The charges for the 15 March releases relate to behavioral, drug and property offenses. The table below details their primary charges.

***Red bars indicate days on which EPRs occurred. Note that EPRs do not always or only occur when capacity exceeds the 97% threshold. Efforts are made to balance the population to the demands of the classification system for specific types of jail beds and balance the space needs for male or female inmates. Additionally, jail capacity varies throughout the day, with these capacity calculations based on 10PM population counts.**
