Monthly Emergency Population Release Report June 2009

In June 2009, a total of 30 inmates left the Multnomah County jail in a series of two forced release events (also known as emergency population releases). More than a year passed between the forced releases in June and the last forced release in March 2008. Of the 30 inmates released, 12 had been jailed pre-trial on a primary charge related to drugs, another 12 jailed for property crimes, and 6 for behavioral crimes. Twenty-six (26) of the 30 were men and 4 were women. The highest risk score among those released was for a drug offender (76). The average risk score among the entire group of forced releases was 43. Drug offenders as a subgroup had the highest average risk score (53), with comparatively lower average risk scores found among those charged with property crimes (38) and behavioral crimes (32).
