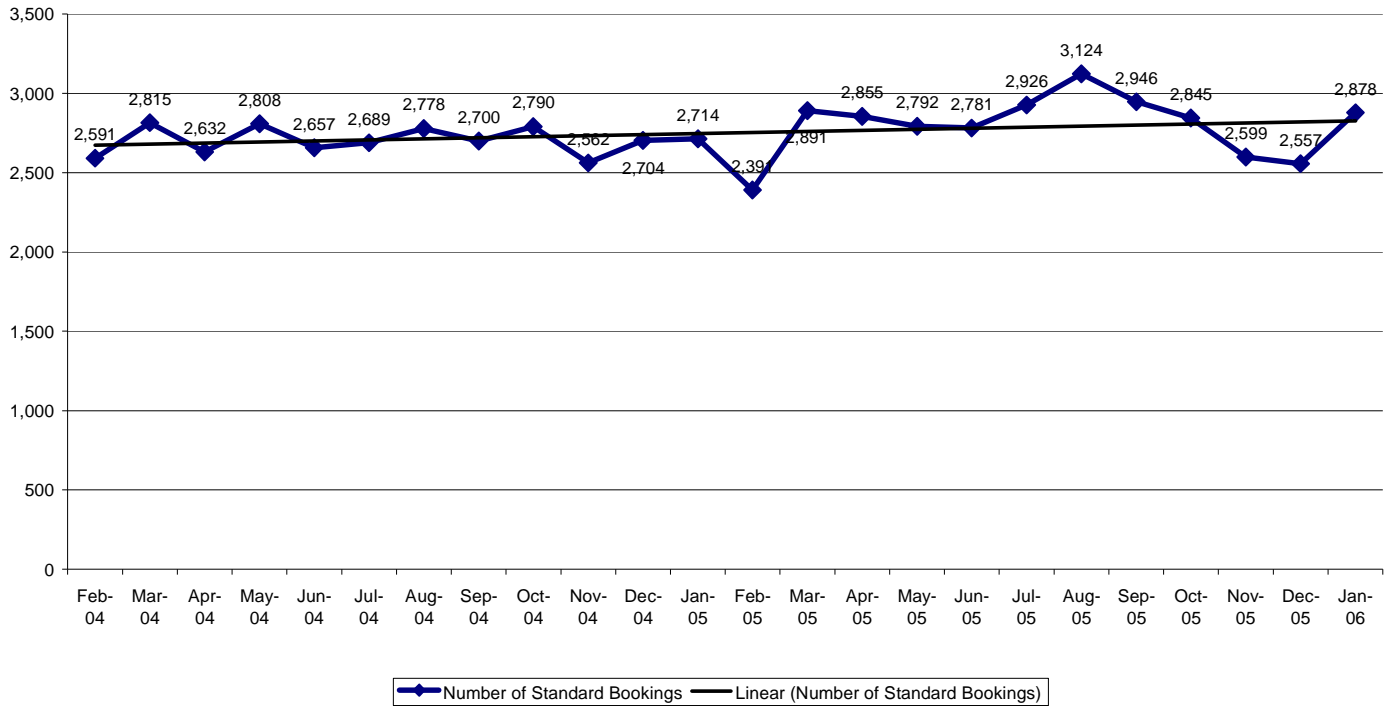


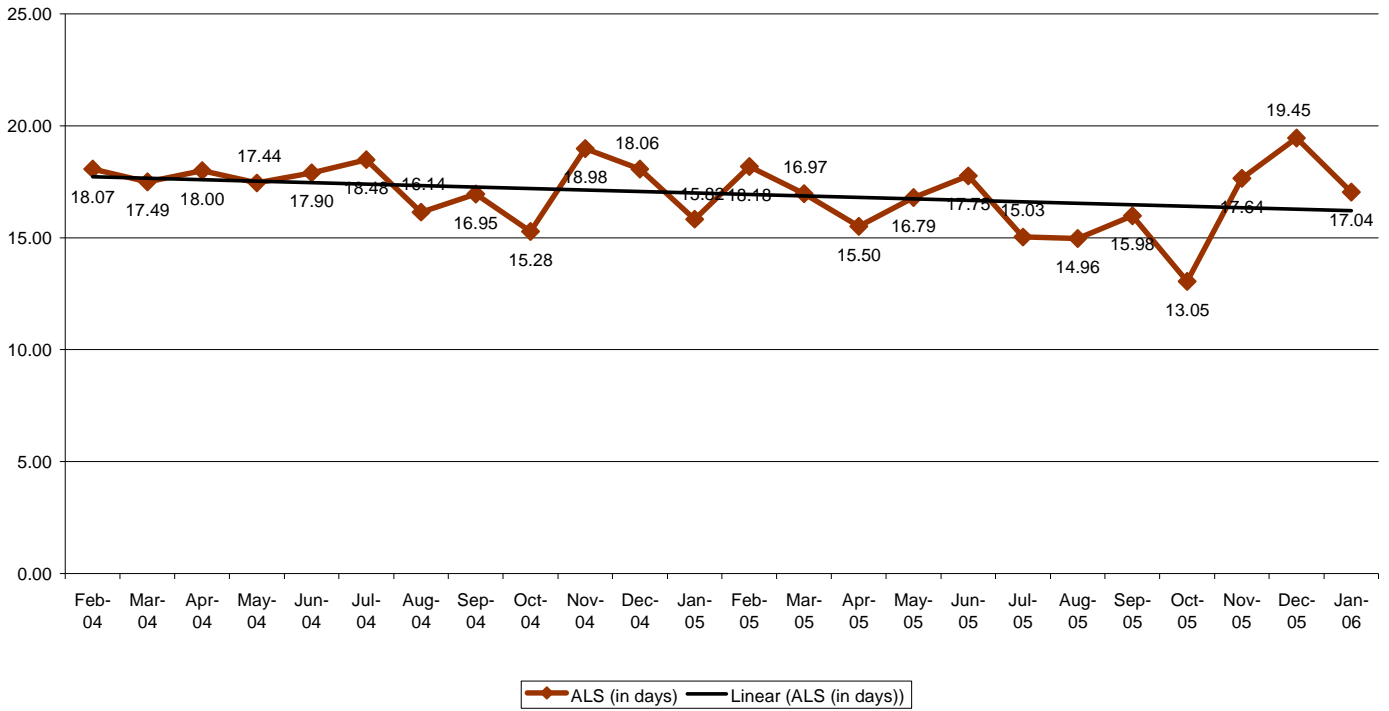
# Multnomah County Monthly Jail Statistics January 2006

For January 2006, Standard Bookings increased by 321 bookings to total 2878 for the month. Turn Self In bookings stayed steady at 267, while Cite & IDs slightly decreased from November and December last year, to total 438. The completion of MCDCC's electronic upgrade allowed an additional floor to reopen to inmates, as the decommissioning of MCCF dictated the relocation of 156 inmates. Jail Capacity remained at 1690 through January. Emergency Population Releases totaled 168 on 9 days during the month. This is slightly higher than December's 81 releases; however still 221% lower than August's high of 541 releases. The average score of those released during January was 31; the lowest average score over the prior 12 months. Average Length of Stay decreased by almost 2.5 days and Average Daily Population fell by 2.2%.

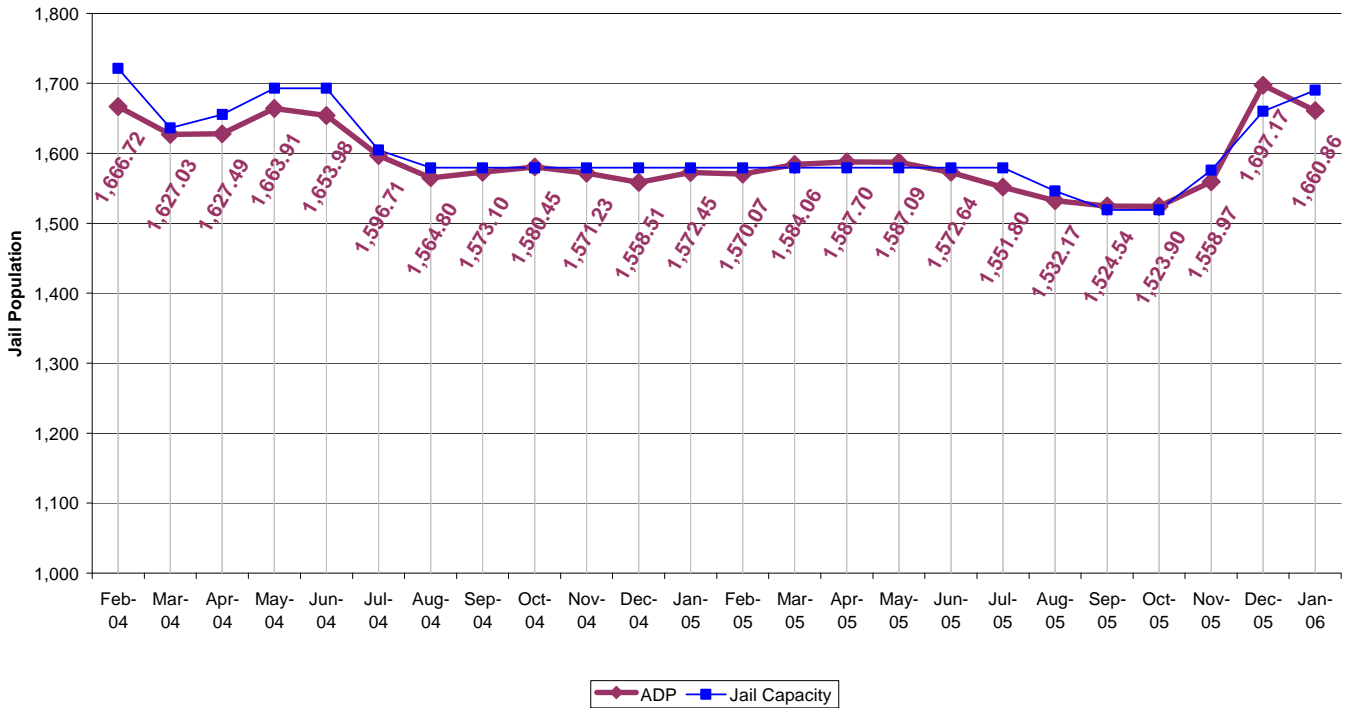
### Standard Bookings: February 2004 - January 2006



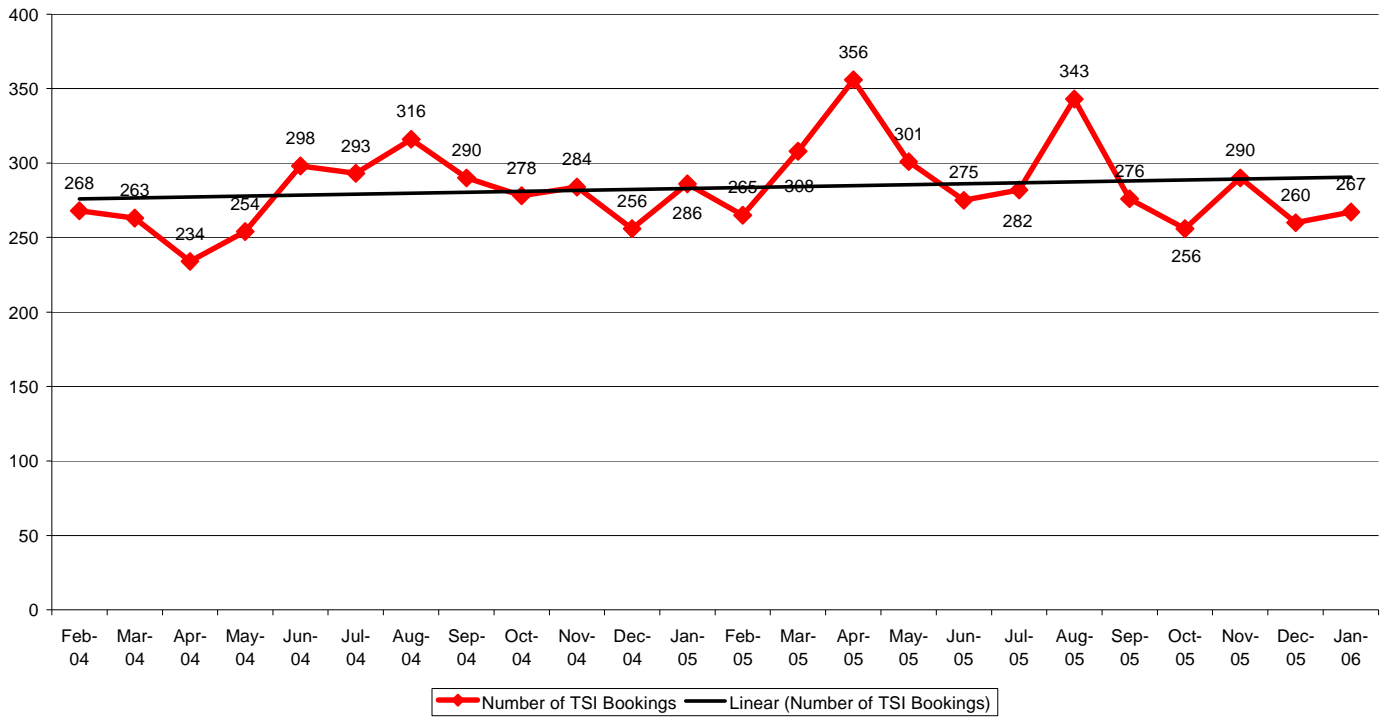
### Average Length of Stay: February 2004 - January 2006



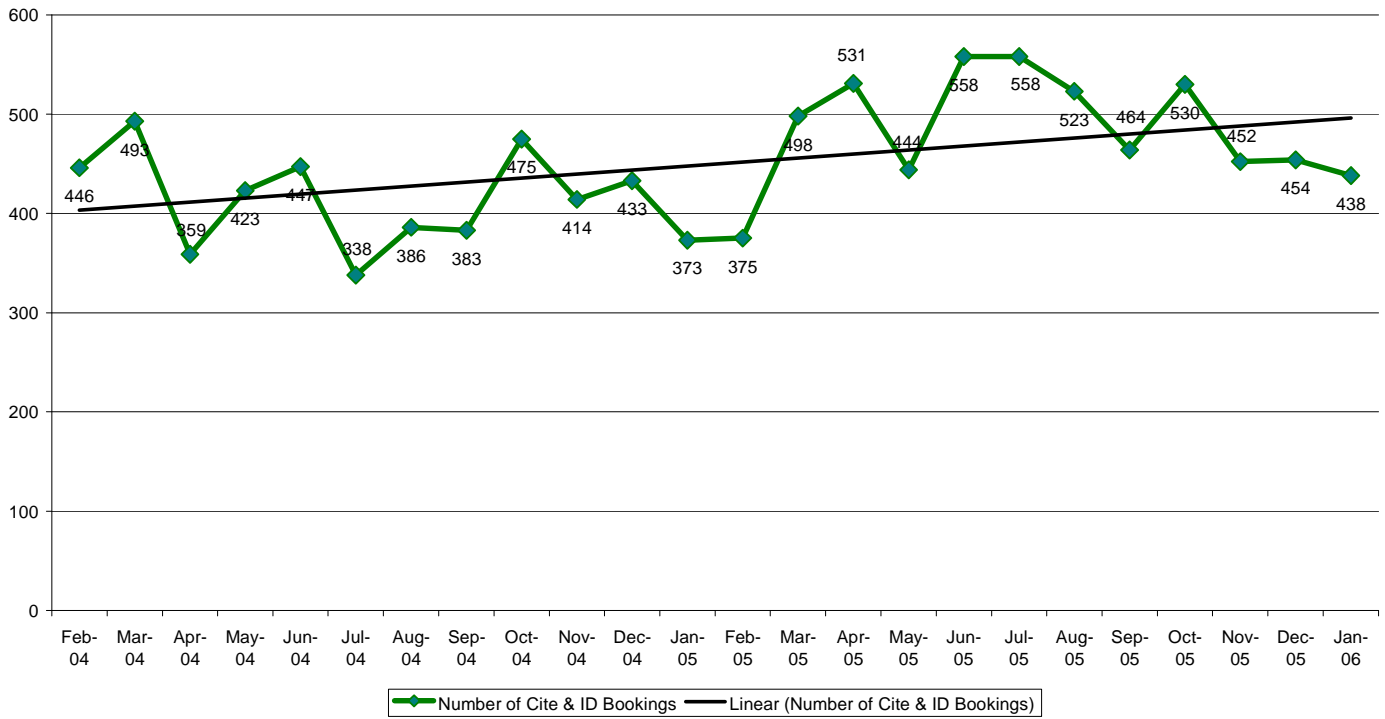
### Average Daily Population: February 2004 - January 2006



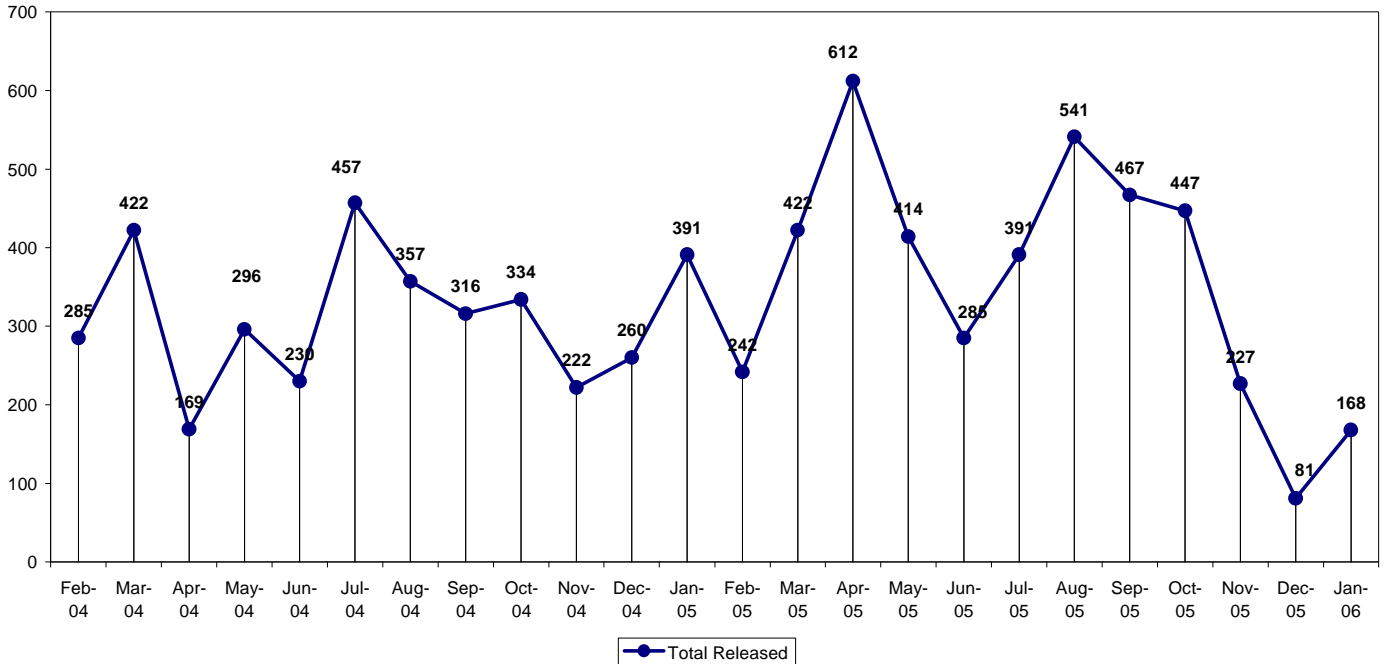
### Turn-Self-In (TSI) Bookings: February 2004 - January 2006
