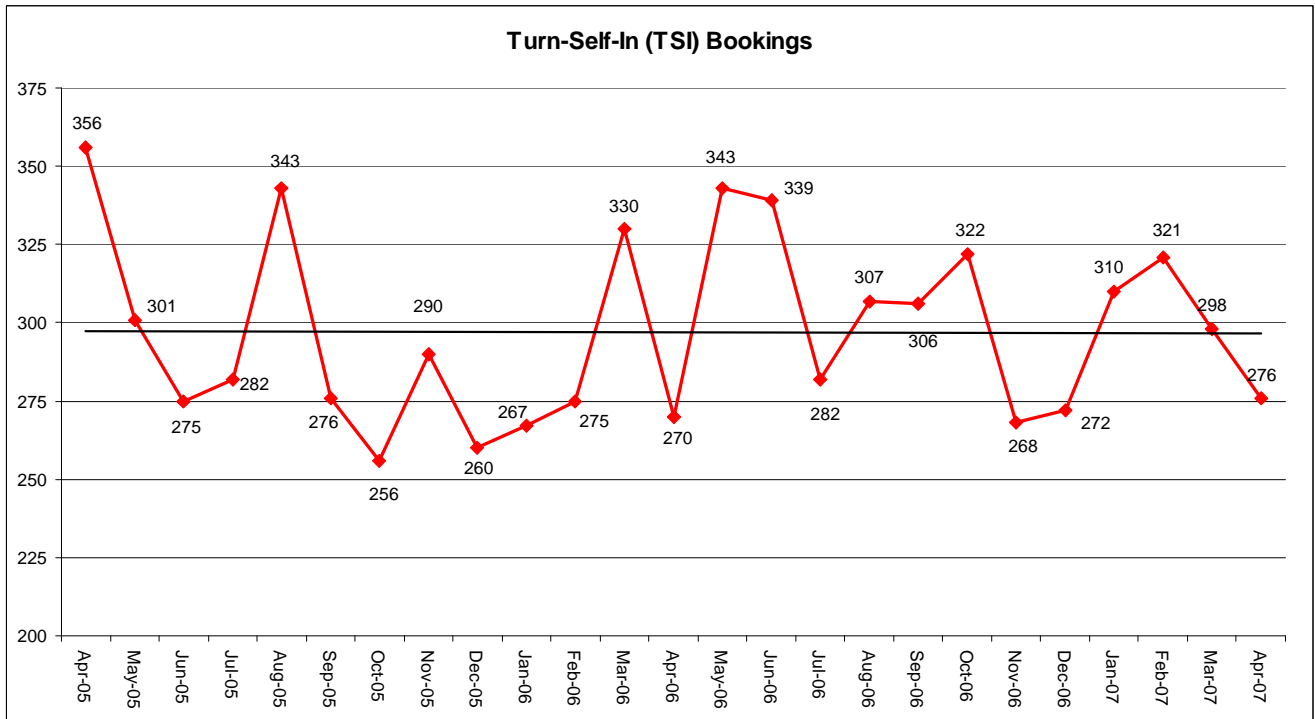
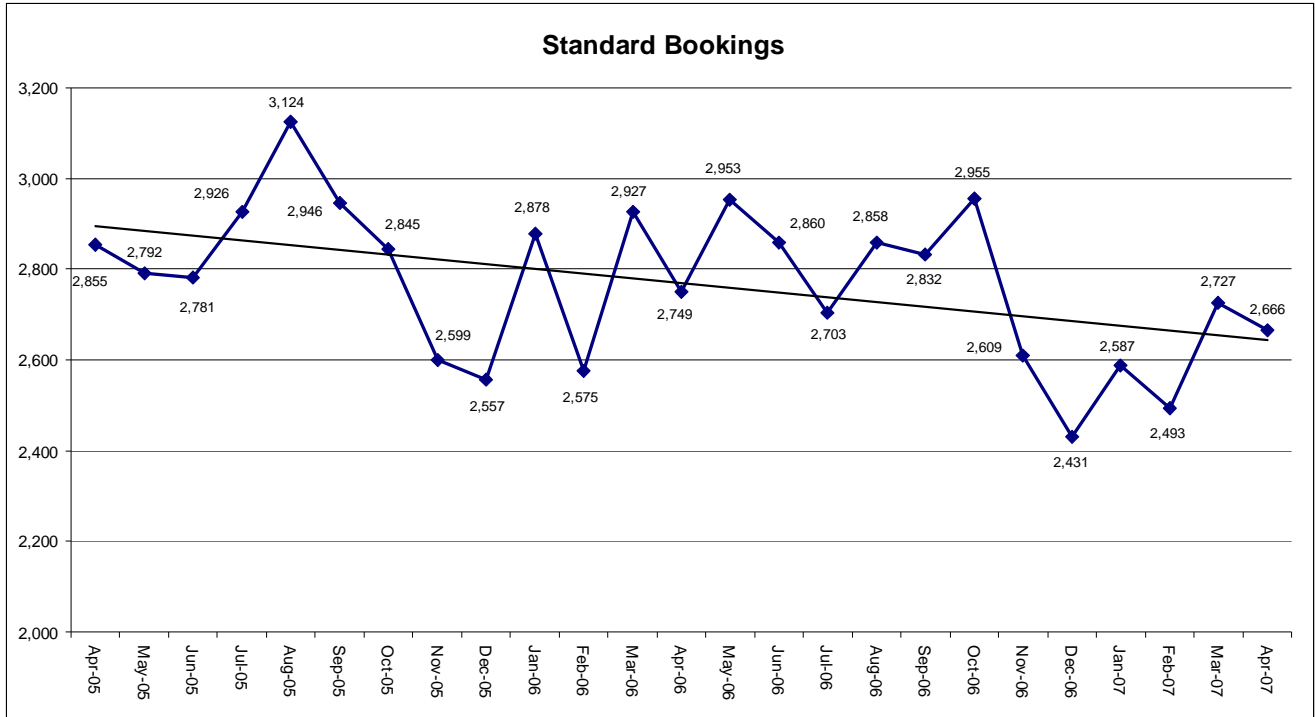

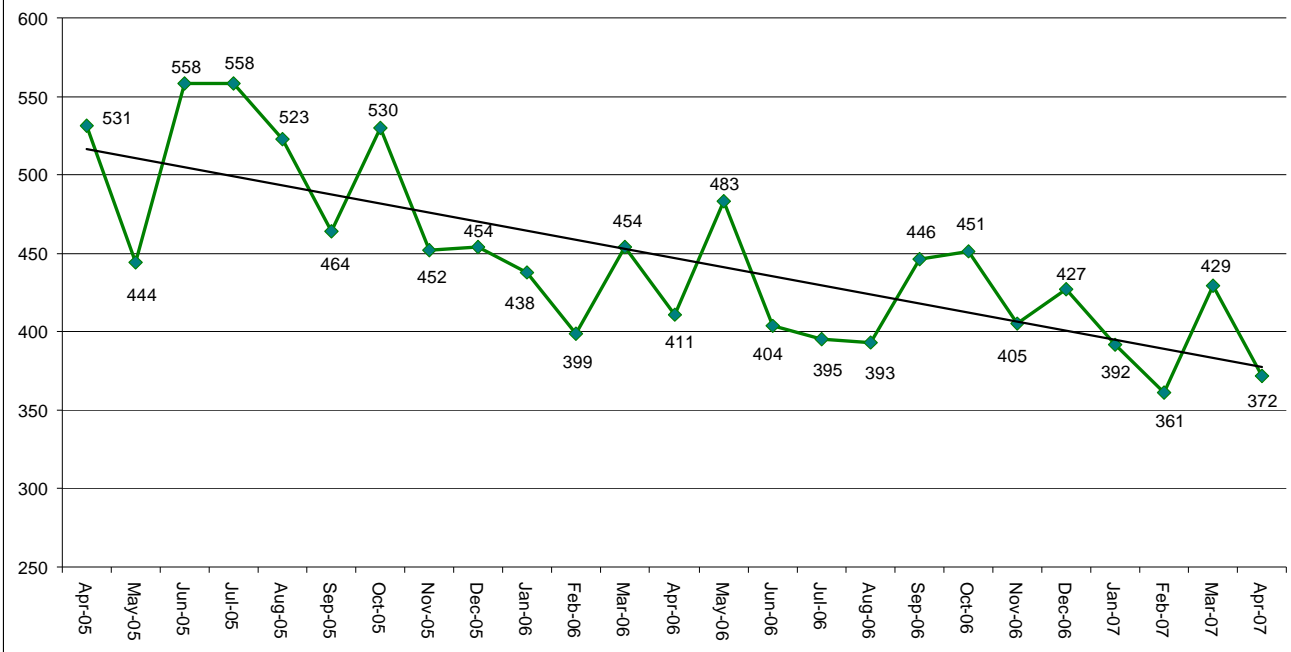

**Multnomah County Monthly Jail Statistics
April 2007**

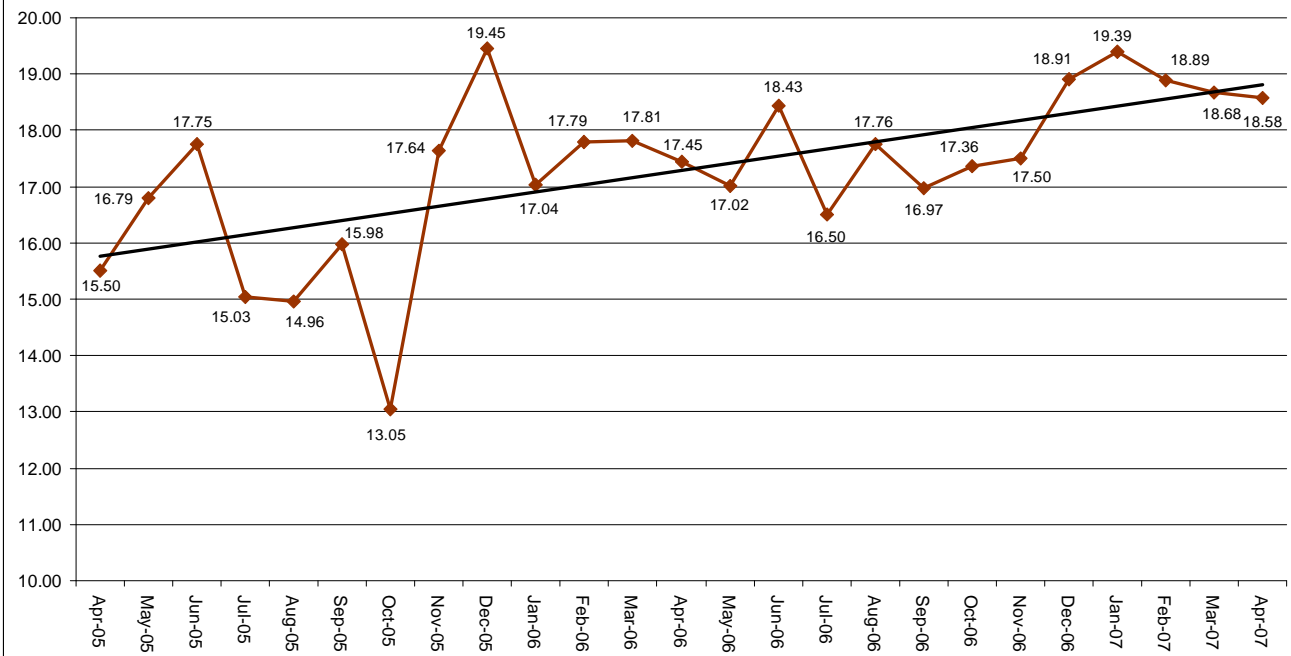
April ended with 2,666 Standard Bookings. This is a 2.2% decrease from the previous month of March. This is a 3.0% decrease from April of 2006 when there were 2,749 Standard Bookings. There were 276 Turn Self-In (TSI) Bookings; a 7.3% decrease from the previous month total of 298. There were a total of 372 Cite and ID's booked; this is a decrease from March when there were 429. The Average Length of Stay (ALS) for April of 2007 was 18.58 days. This is closely similar to March's ALS of 18.68. The Average Daily Population (ADP) increased by 3.0% ending at 1,605.89 for April. This is a 5.4% decrease from April 2006 when the ADP was 1698.83. Emergency Population Releases occurred three times for the month of April. A total of 36 individuals were released due to exceeding population limits. This is an increase from the previous month of March. The average Emergency Population Release score was 33. Bookings for the Portland Project 57 totaled 397 for April. This is a 10.7% decrease from the March which reported 445 P57 bookings. This report includes visual graphs and charts for longitudinal representation.

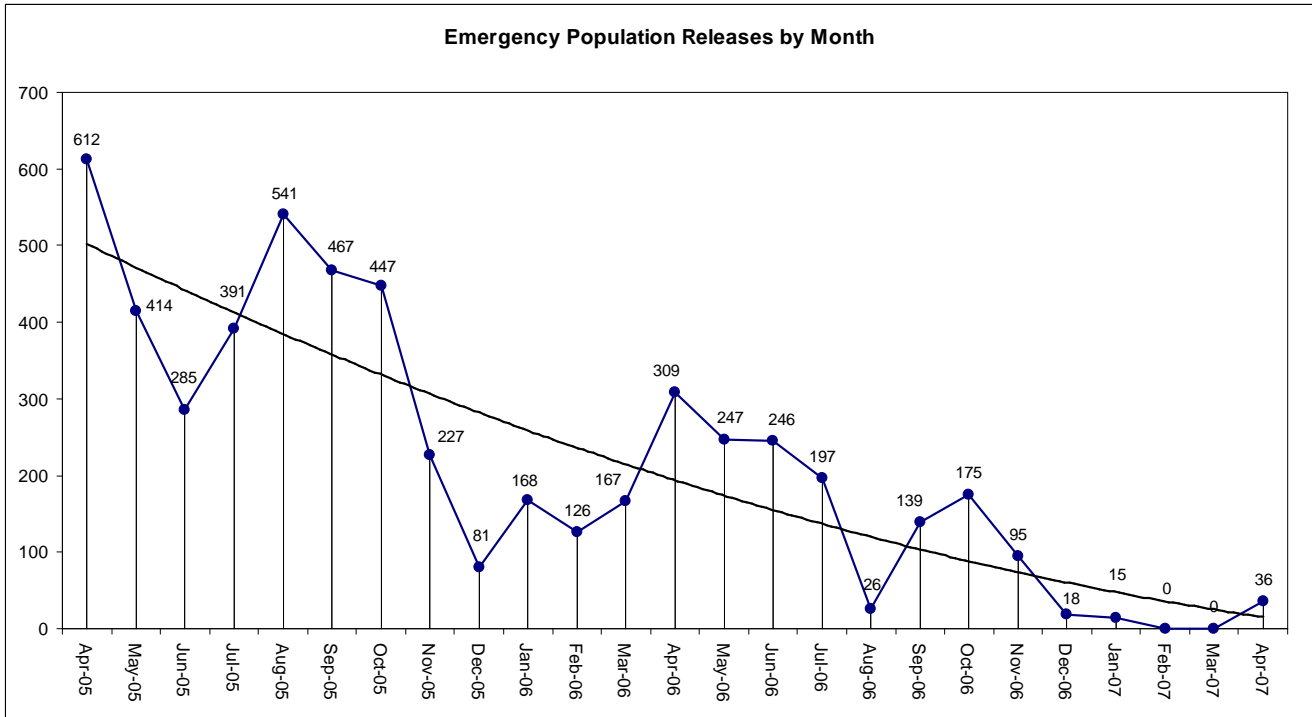
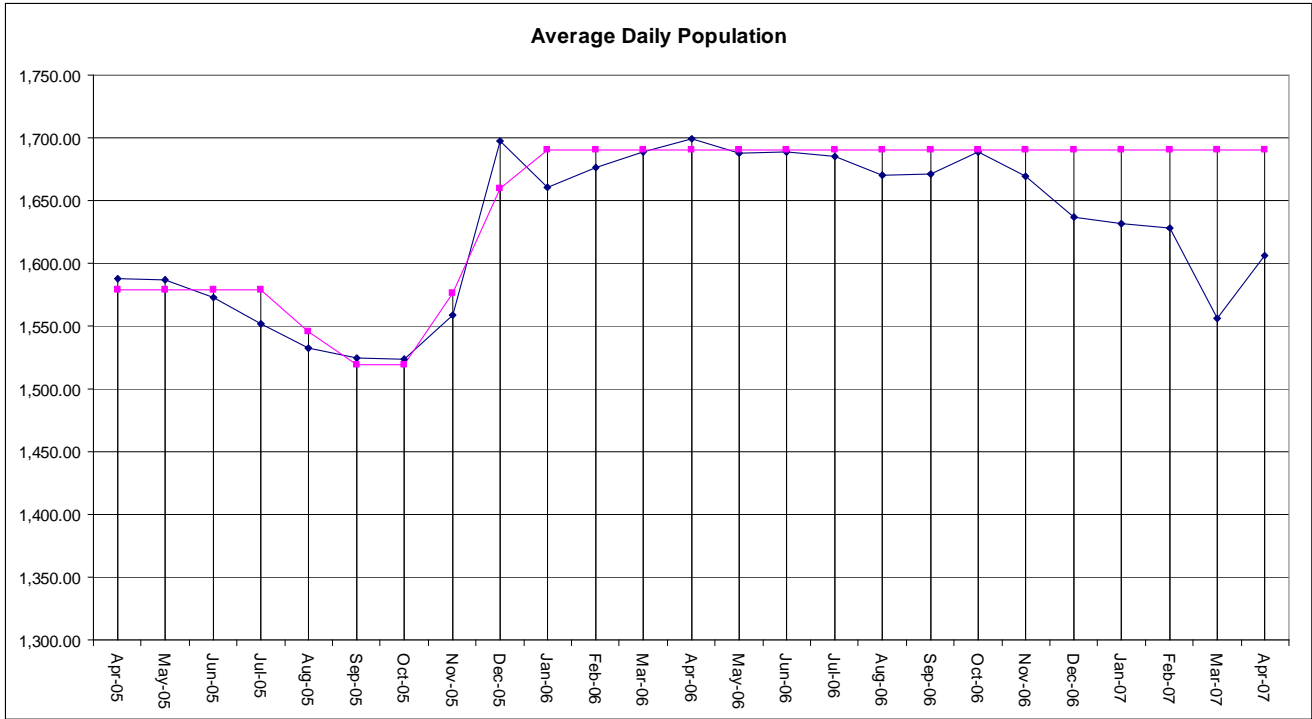

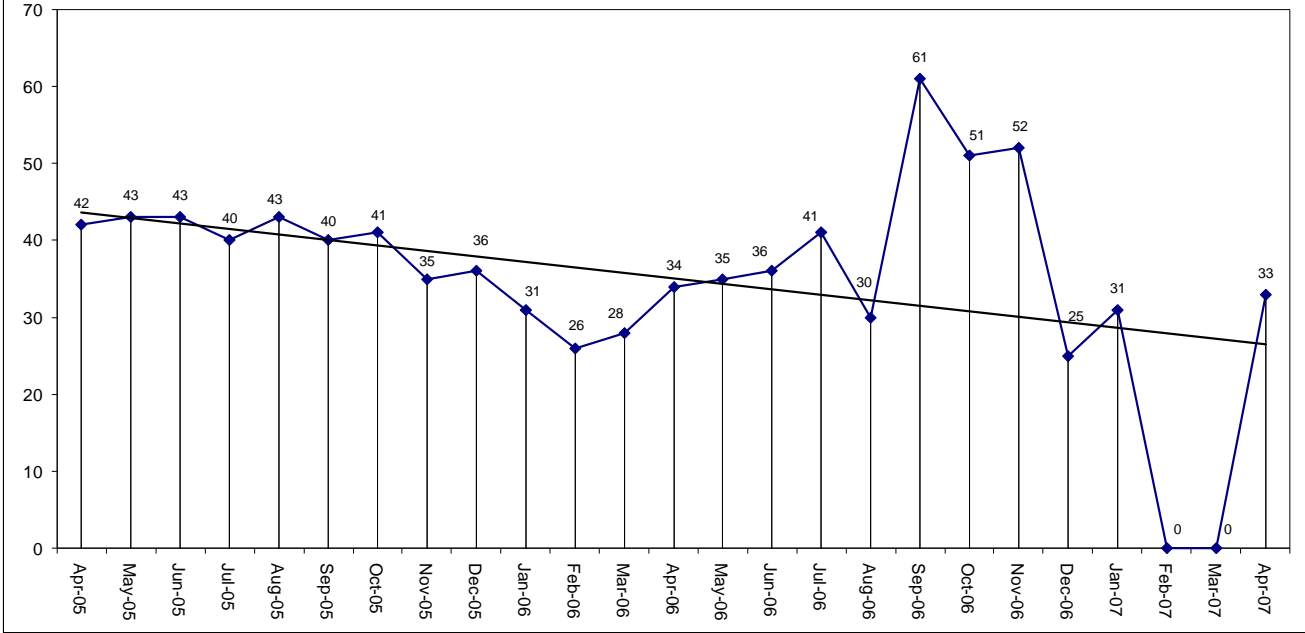


Average Length of Stay

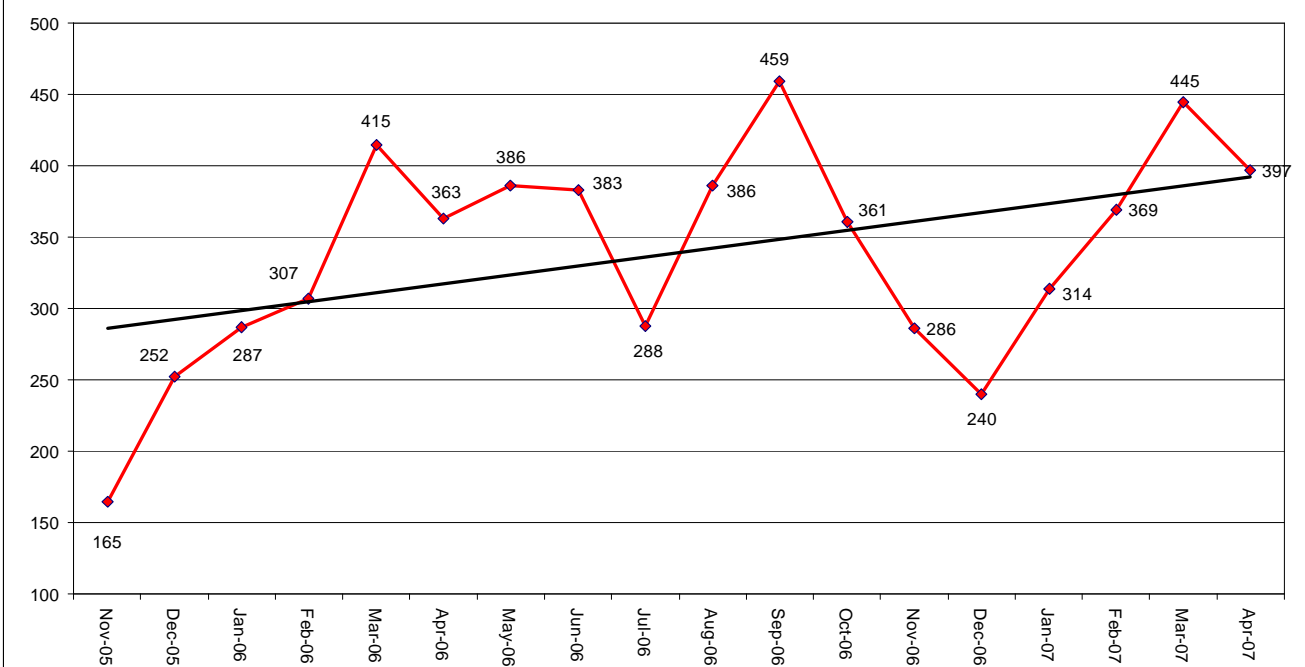




**Monthly Average Score of
