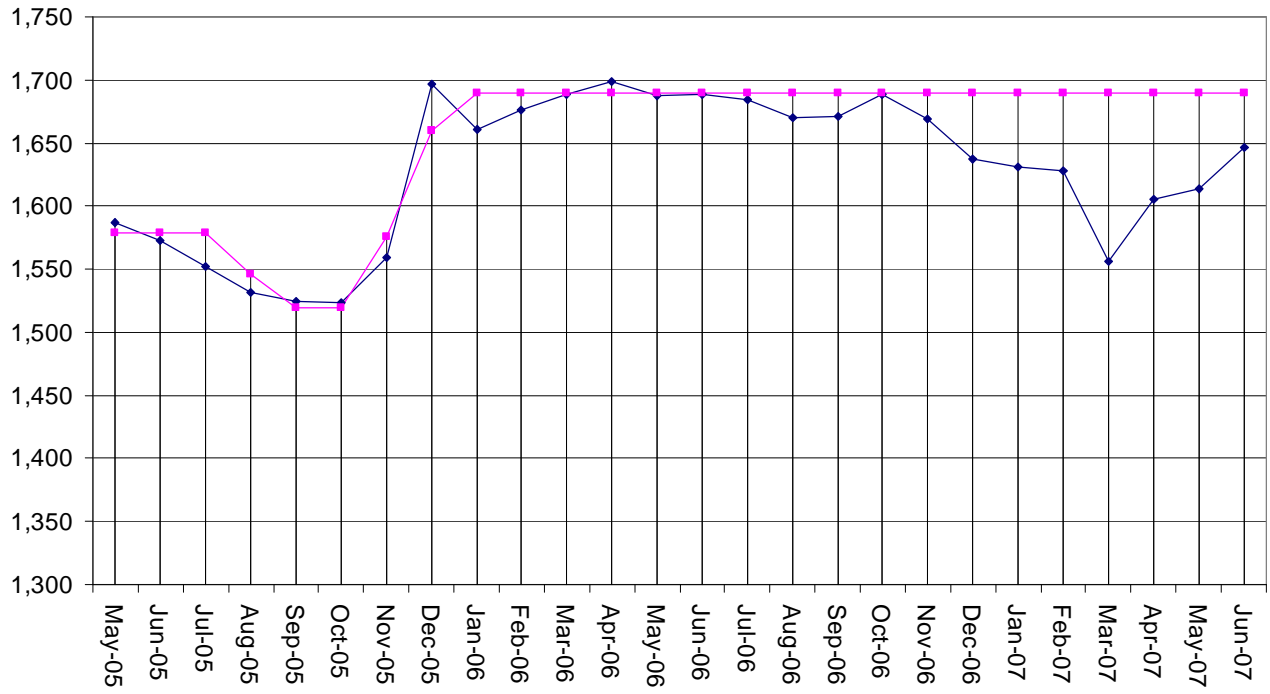
**Multnomah County Monthly Jail Statistics  
June 2007**

The month of June ended with 2,781 Standard Bookings. This is a .88% decrease from May. This is a 2.82% decrease from June of 2006 when there were 2,860 Standard Bookings. There were a total of 371 Cite and ID's booked; this is a slight decrease from May when there were 377. The Average Length of Stay (ALS) for June of 2007 was 16.32 days. This is relatively similar from the previous month. The Average Daily Population (ADP) for June is 1,646. This is a 2.5% decrease from June 2006. Emergency Population Releases occurred eleven times for the month of June. A total of 159 individuals were released early. This is an increase from the previous month of May. The average Emergency Population Release score was 75.82. Bookings for the Portland Project 57 totaled 418 for June. The average number of exclusive U.S. Marshall Prisoners for June is 169.

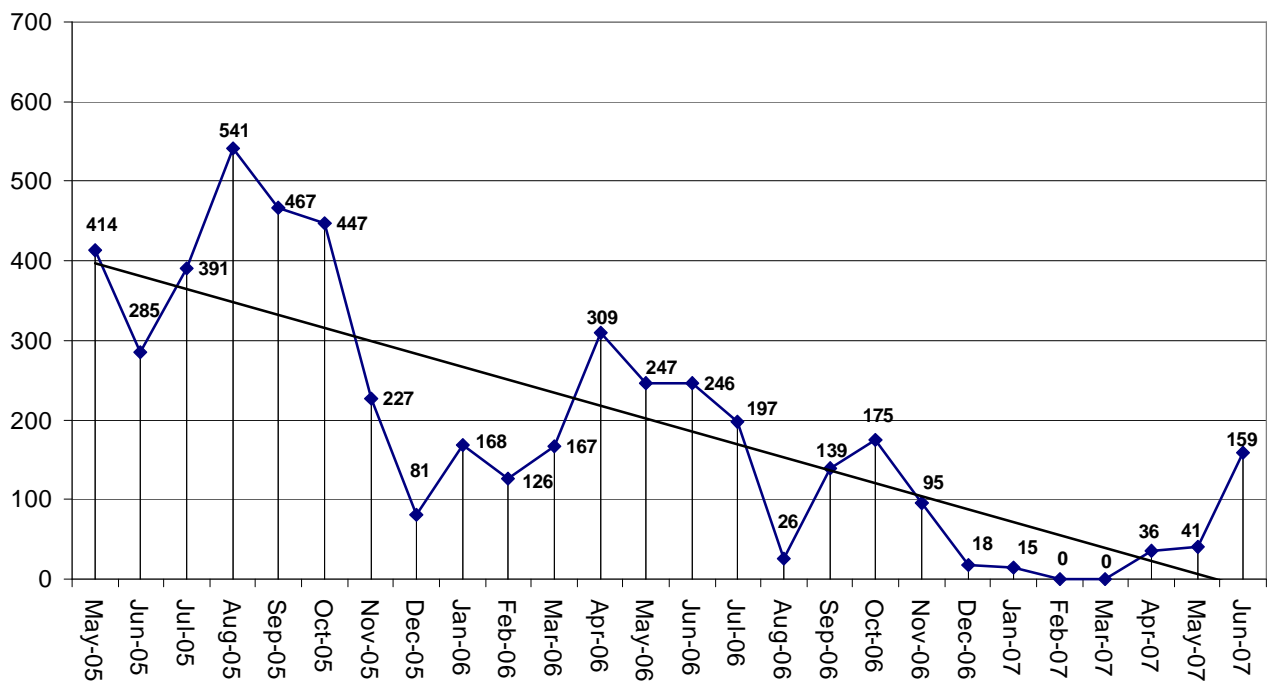




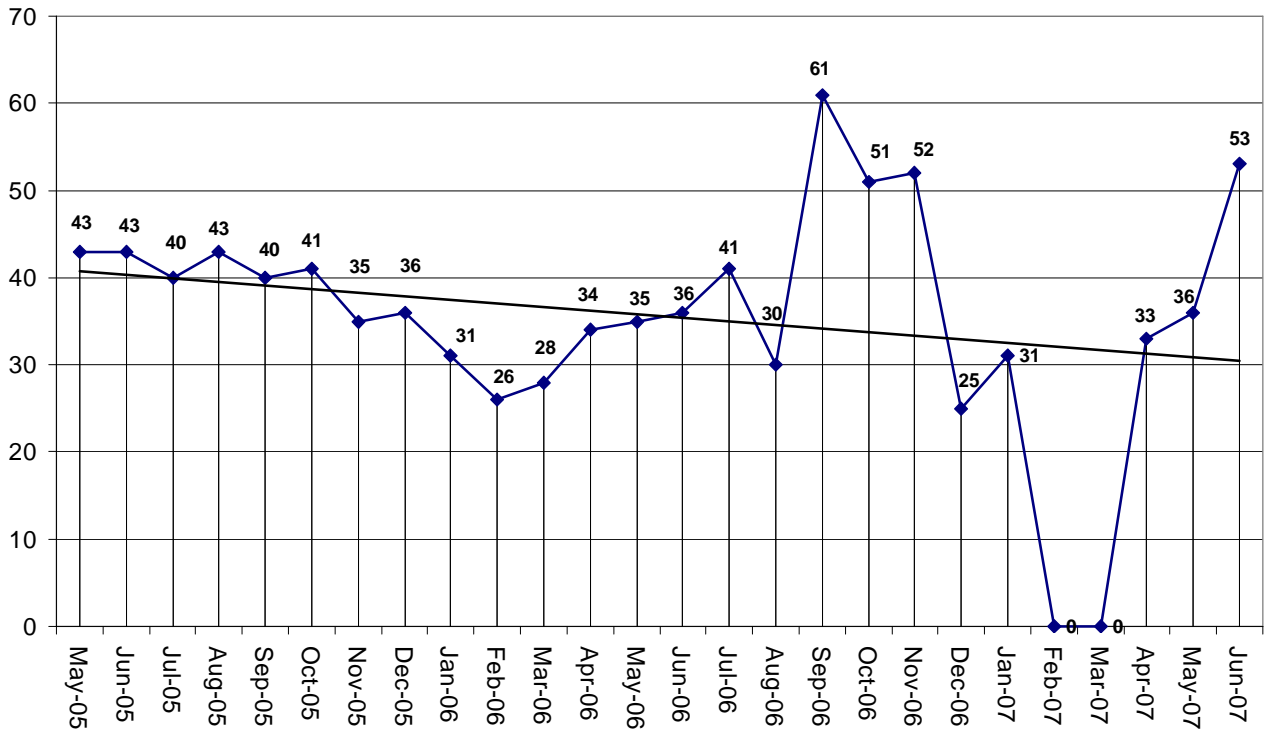
### Average Daily Population



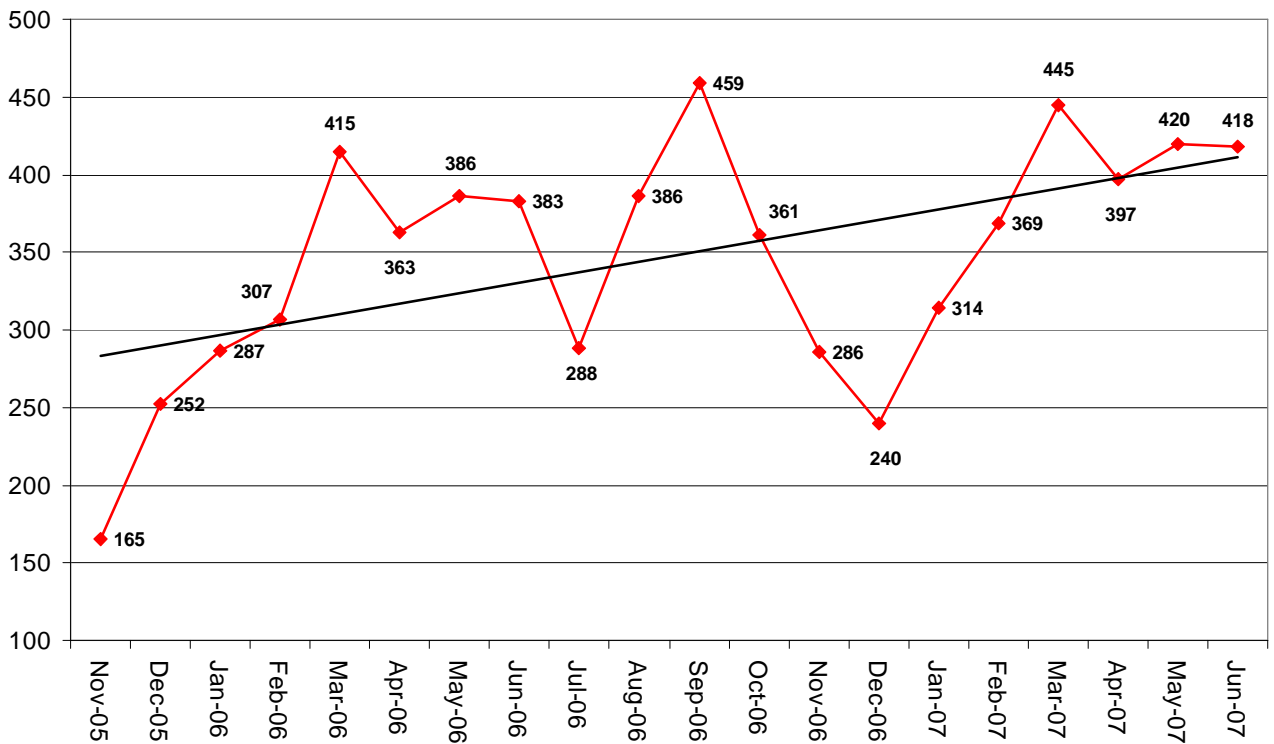
### Emergency Population Releases by Month



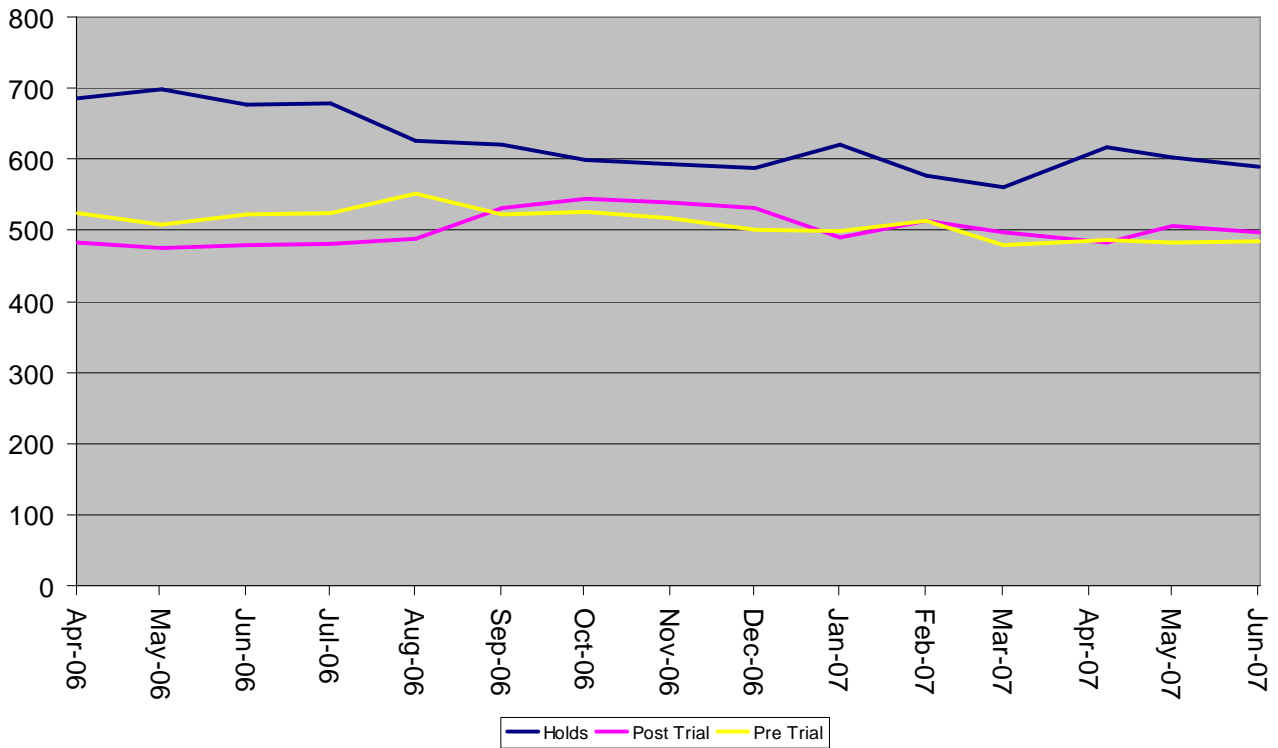
### Monthly Average Score of Emergency Population Releases
