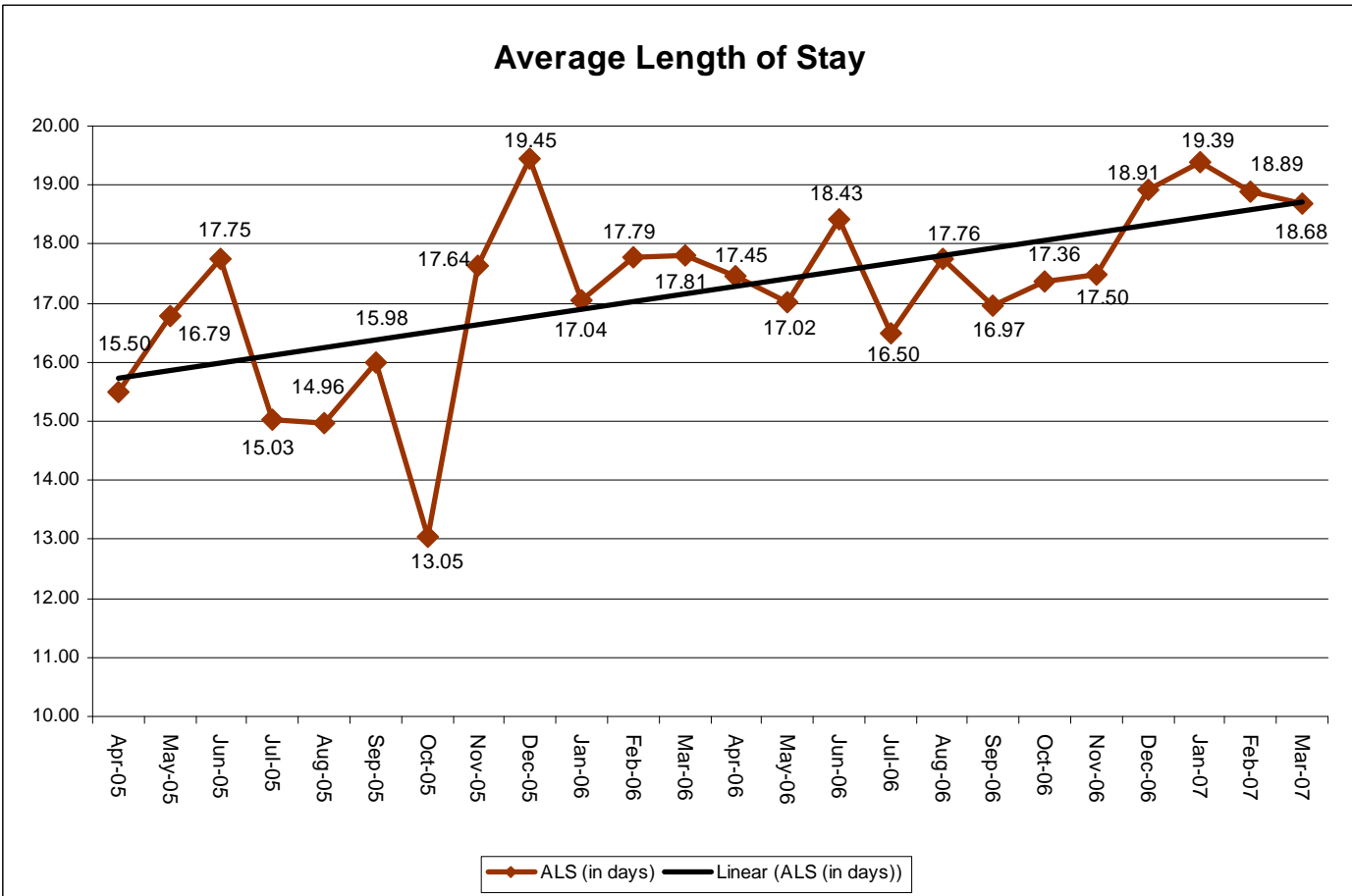

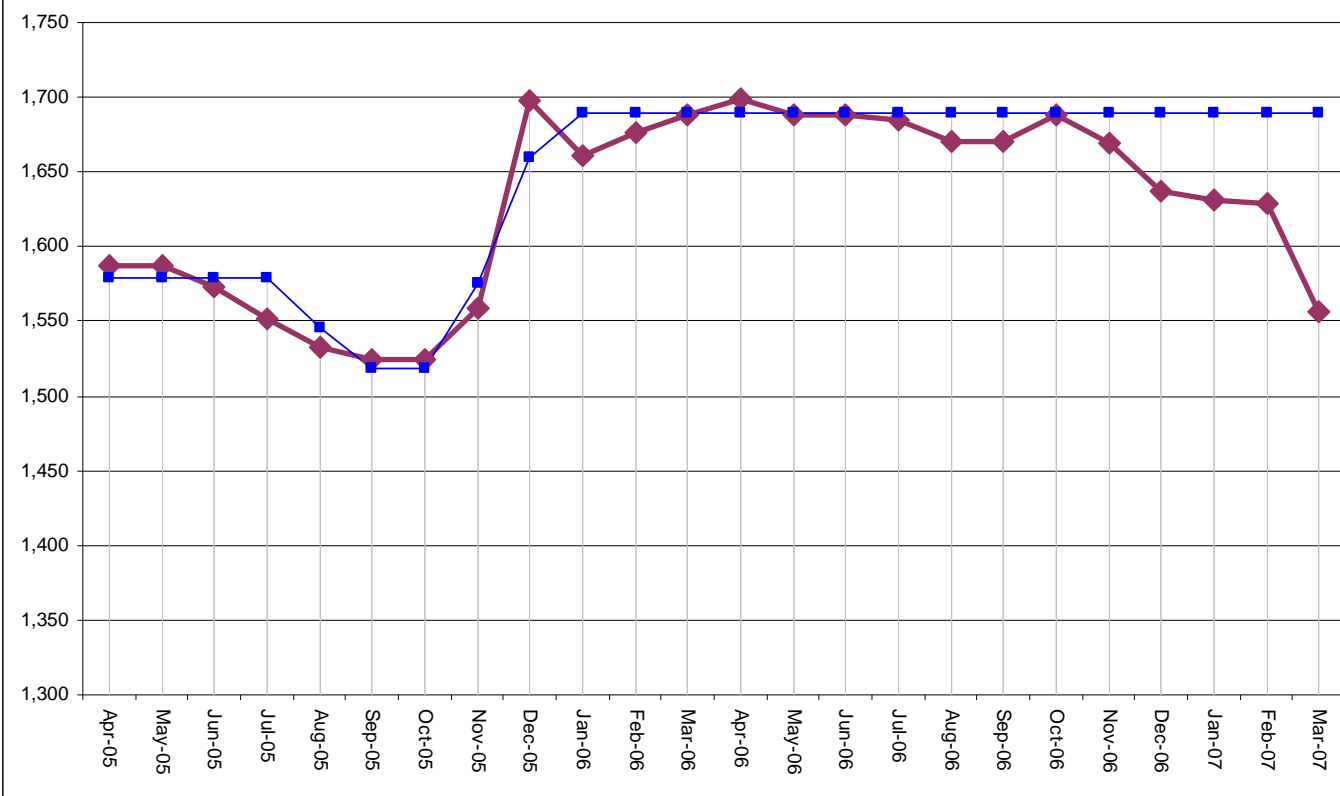
Multnomah County Monthly Jail Statistics March 2007

March ended with 2,727 Standard Bookings. This is a 9.3% increase from the previous month of February. This is a 6.8% decrease from March of 2006 when we ended with 2,927 Standard Bookings. There were 298 Turn Self In (TSI) Bookings; a 7% decrease from the previous month's total of 321. There were a total of 429 Cite and ID's booked; this is an increase from February when Cite & IDs had dropped to 361. The Average Length of Stay (ALS) for March of 2007 was 18.68 days; which is virtually the same as February's ALS of 18.89. The Average Daily Population (ADP) decreased by 4.4% ending at 1,556.25 for March. This is a 7.8% decrease from March of 2006 when the ADP was 1,688.62. There were no emergency population releases for February or March of 2007. Bookings for the Portland Project 57 totaled 445 for March. This is a 17% increase from February 2007 which reported 369 P57 bookings. This report includes visual graphs and charts for longitudinal representation.

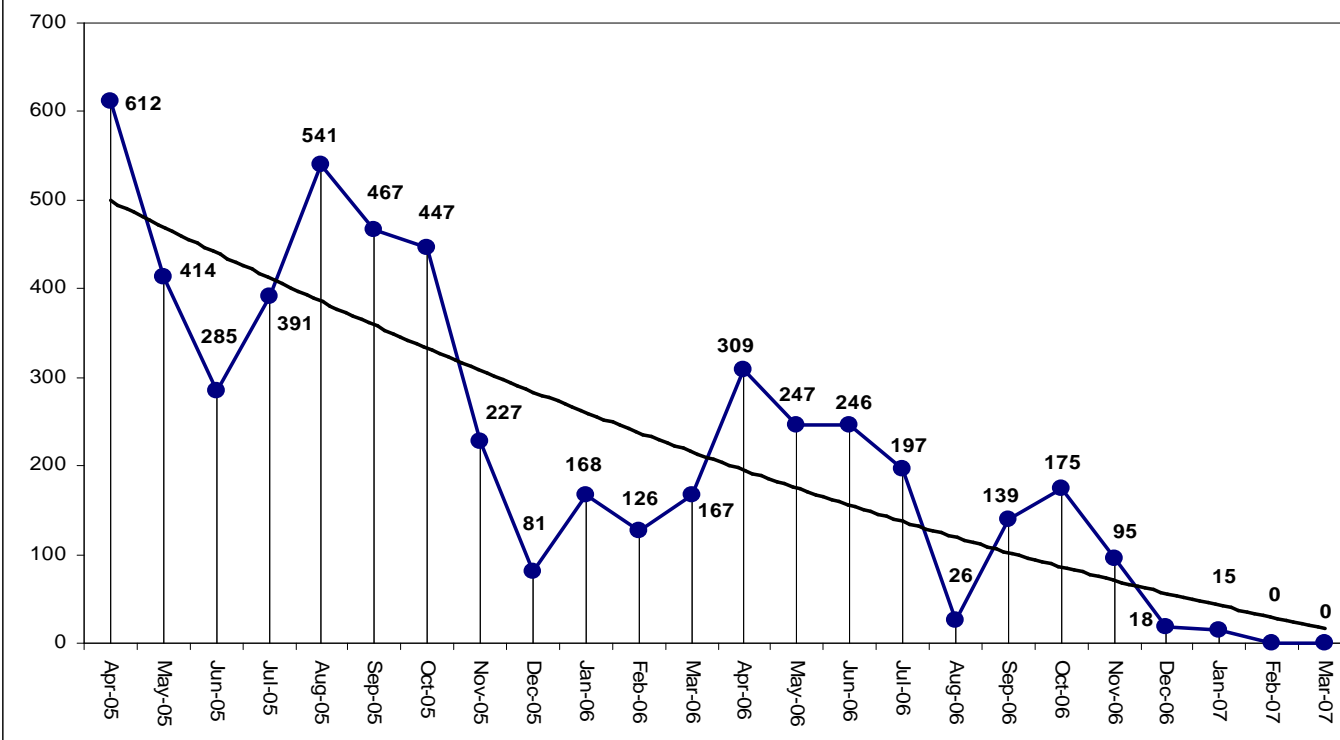




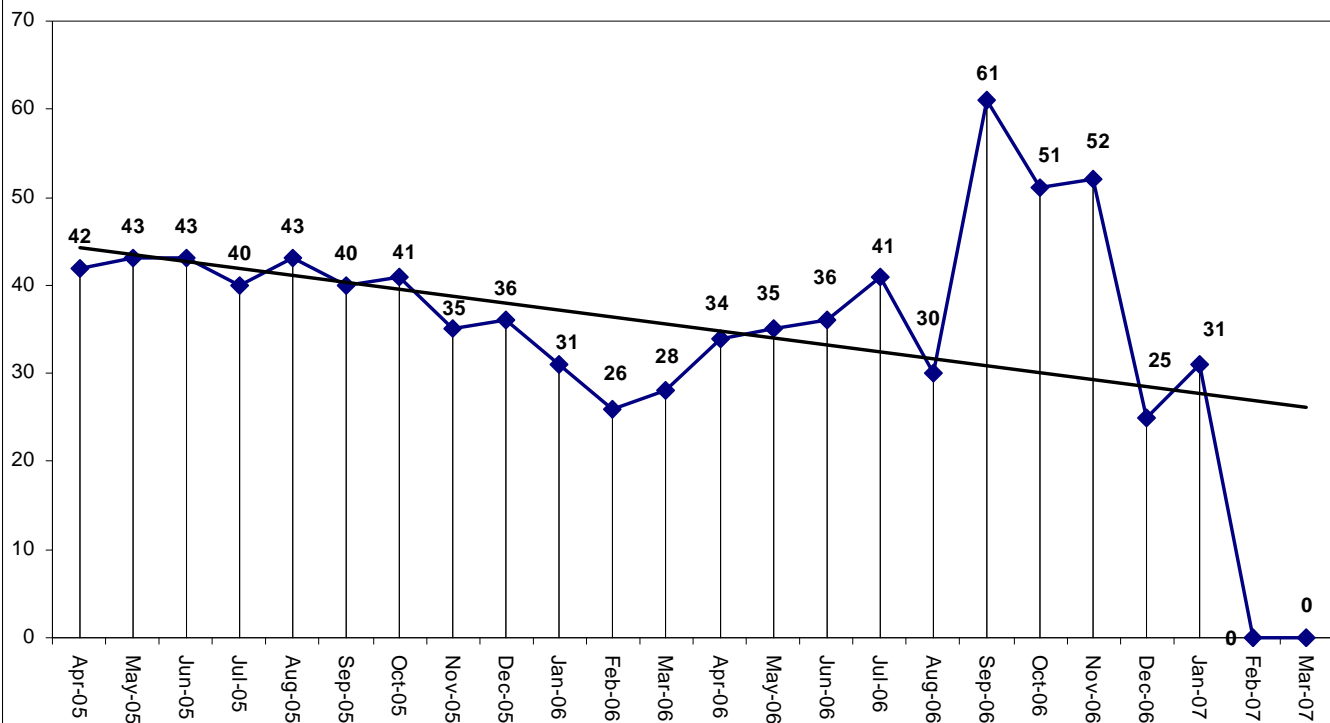
Average Daily Population



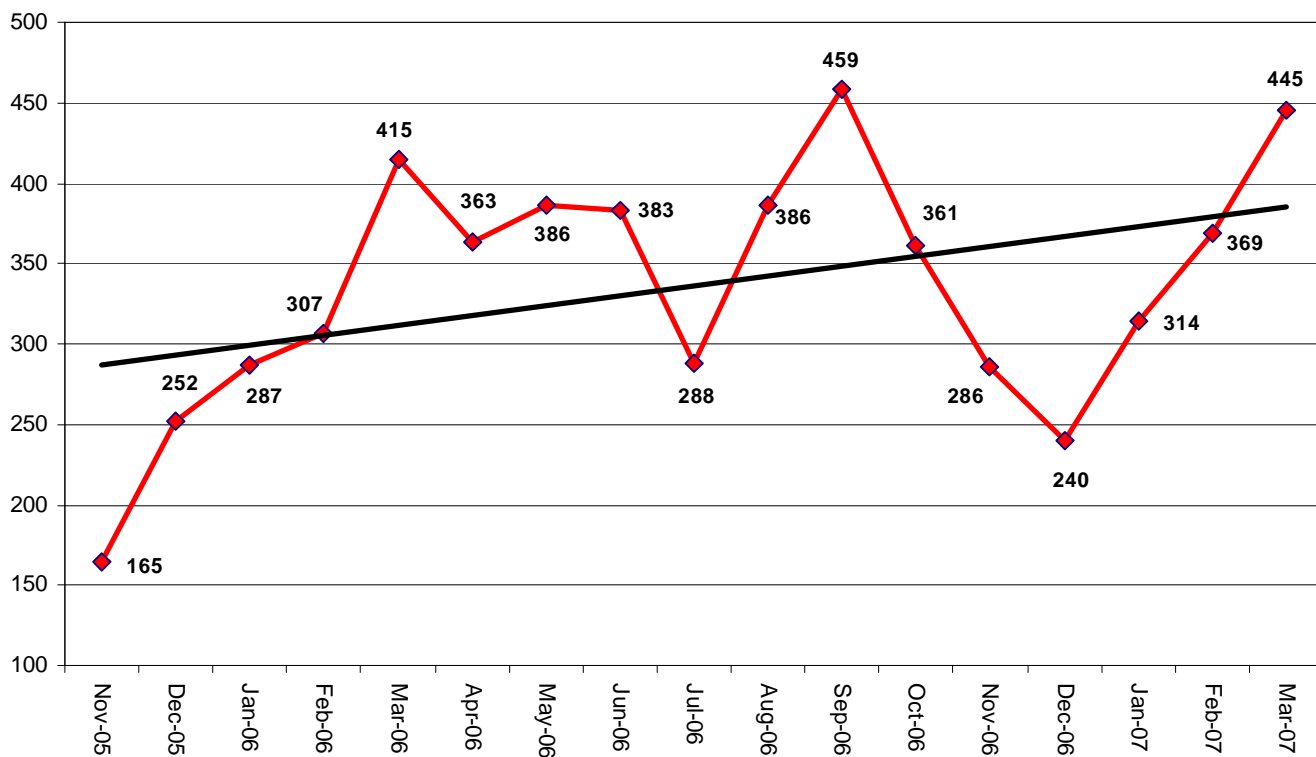
Emergency Population Releases by Month
