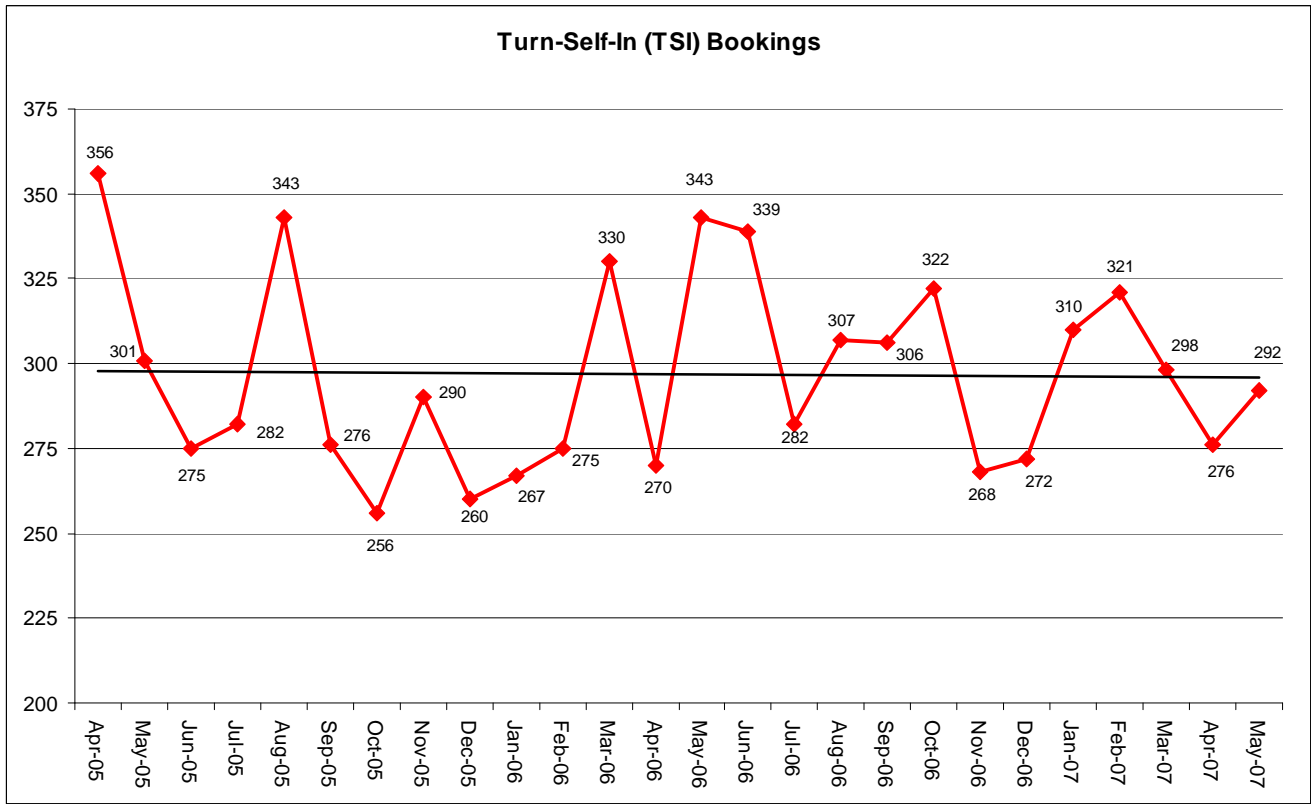
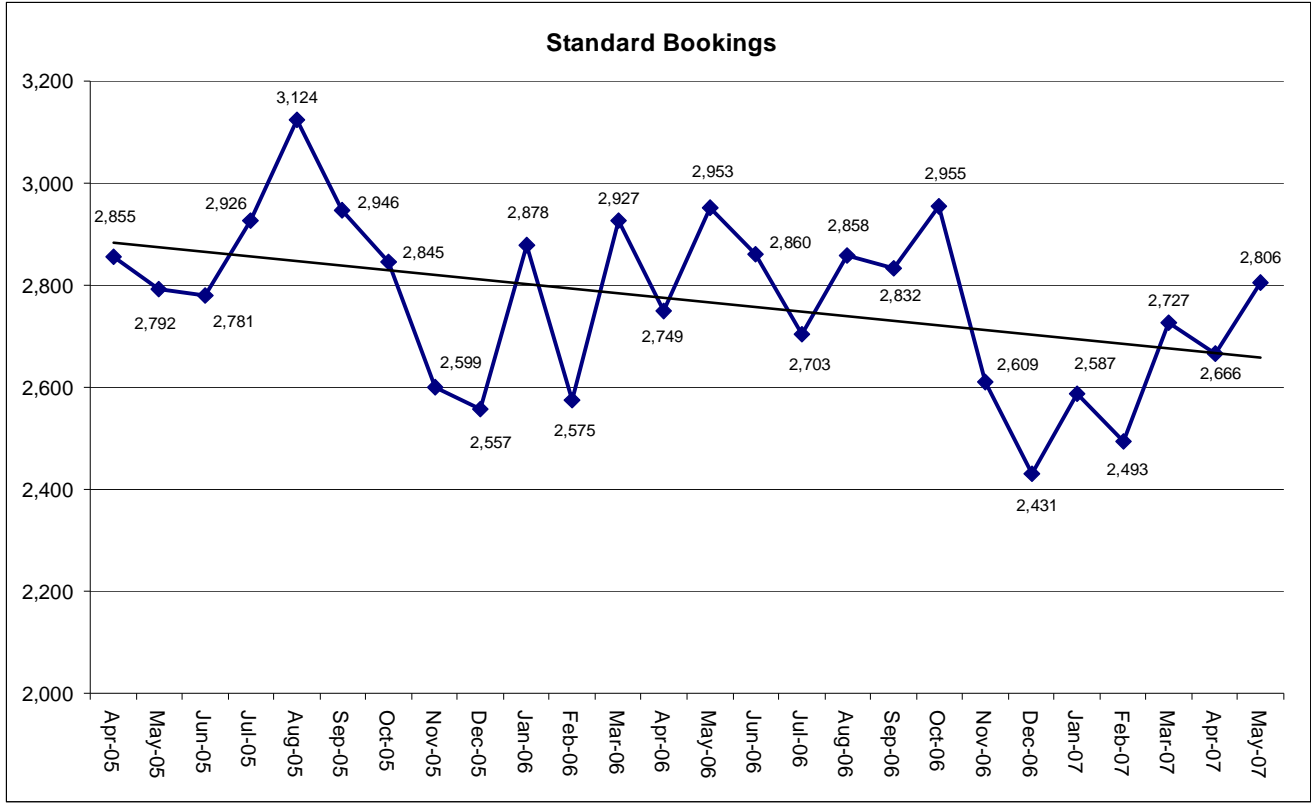

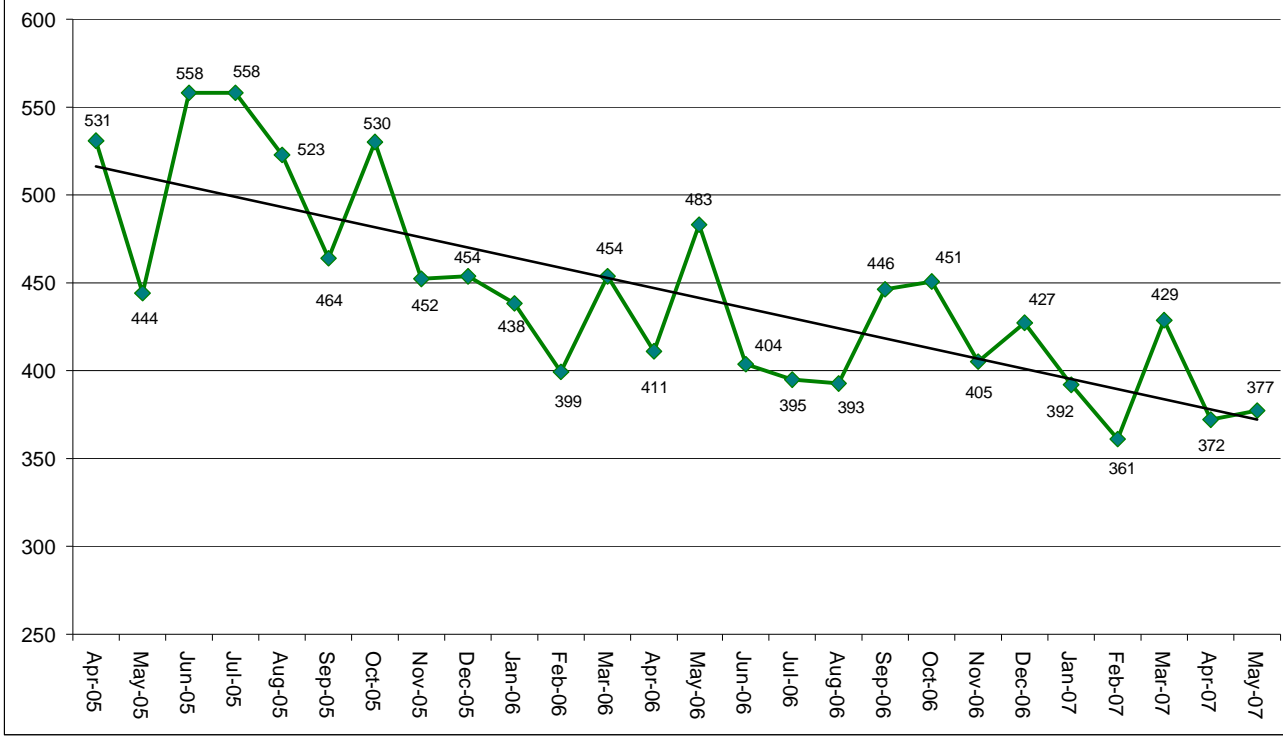

**Multnomah County Monthly Jail Statistics
May 2007**

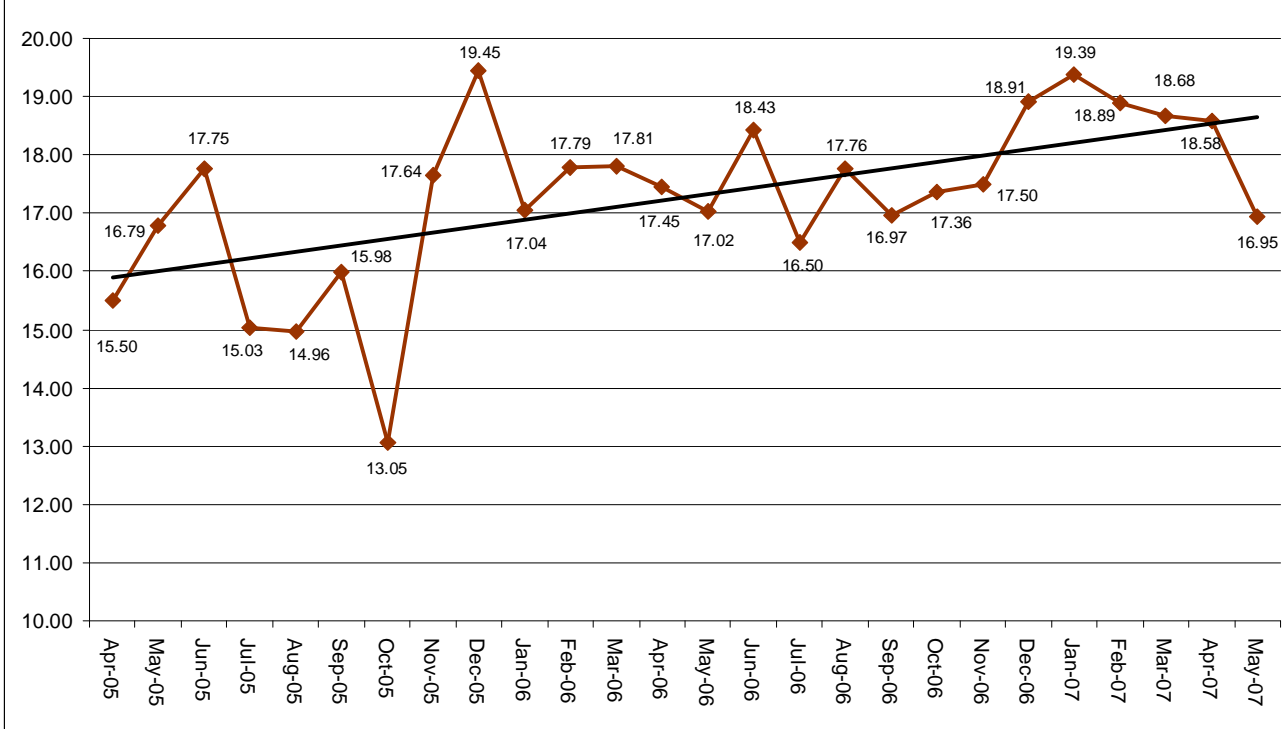
The month of May ended with 2,806 Standard Bookings. This is a 4.98% increase from the previous month of April. This is a 4.97% decrease from May of 2006 when there were 2,953 Standard Bookings. There were 292 Turn Self-In (TSI) Bookings; a 5.47% decrease from the previous month total of 276. There were a total of 377 Cite and ID's booked; this is a slight increase from April when there were 372. The Average Length of Stay (ALS) for May of 2007 was 16.95 days. This is a decrease from the previous months which maintained a (ALS) of about 18.89. The Average Daily Population (ADP) was relatively similar to the previous month ending at 1,613.36 for May. This is a 4.45% decrease from May 2006 when the ADP was 1688.62. Emergency Population Releases occurred three times for the month of May. A total of 41 individuals were released due to exceeding population limits. This is an increase from the previous month of April. The average Emergency Population Release score was 55. Bookings for the Portland Project 57 totaled 420 for May. This is a 5.4% increase from the April which reported 397 P57 bookings. This report includes visual graphs and charts for longitudinal representation.

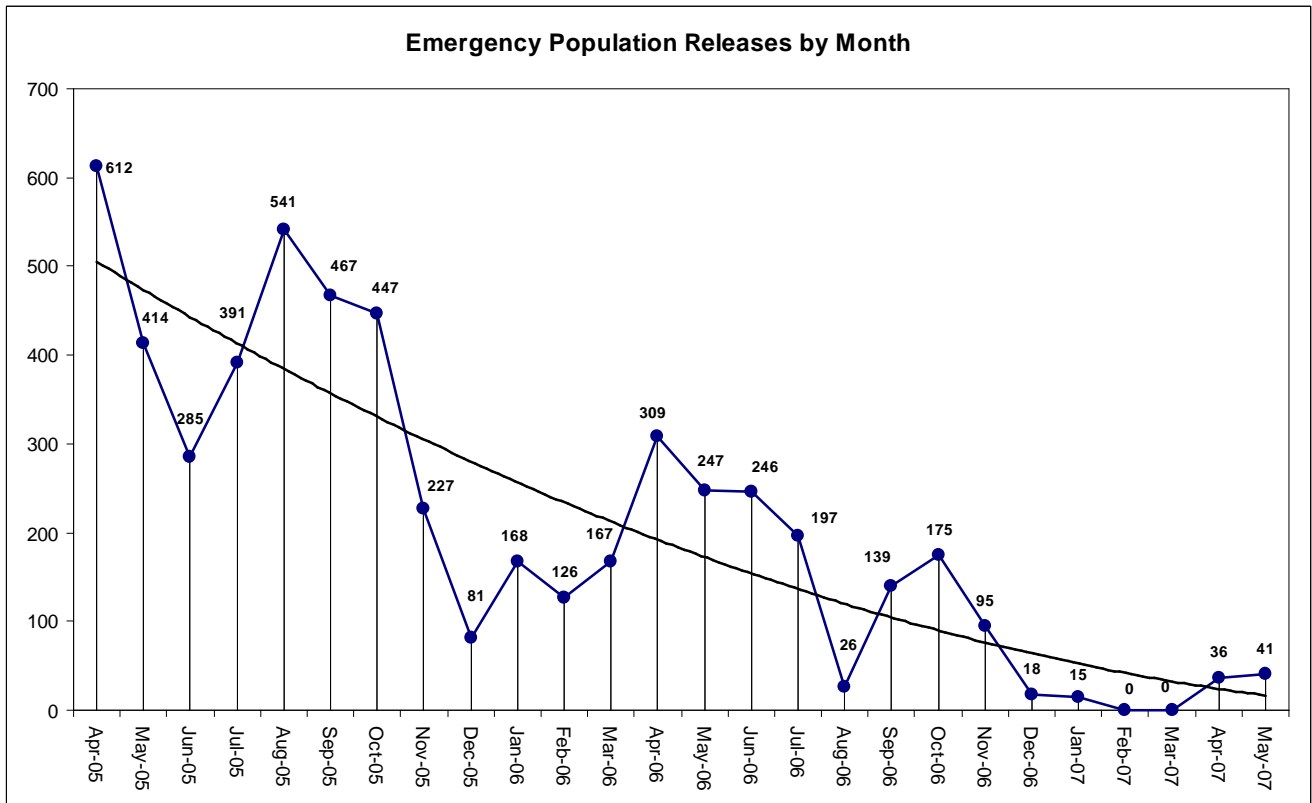
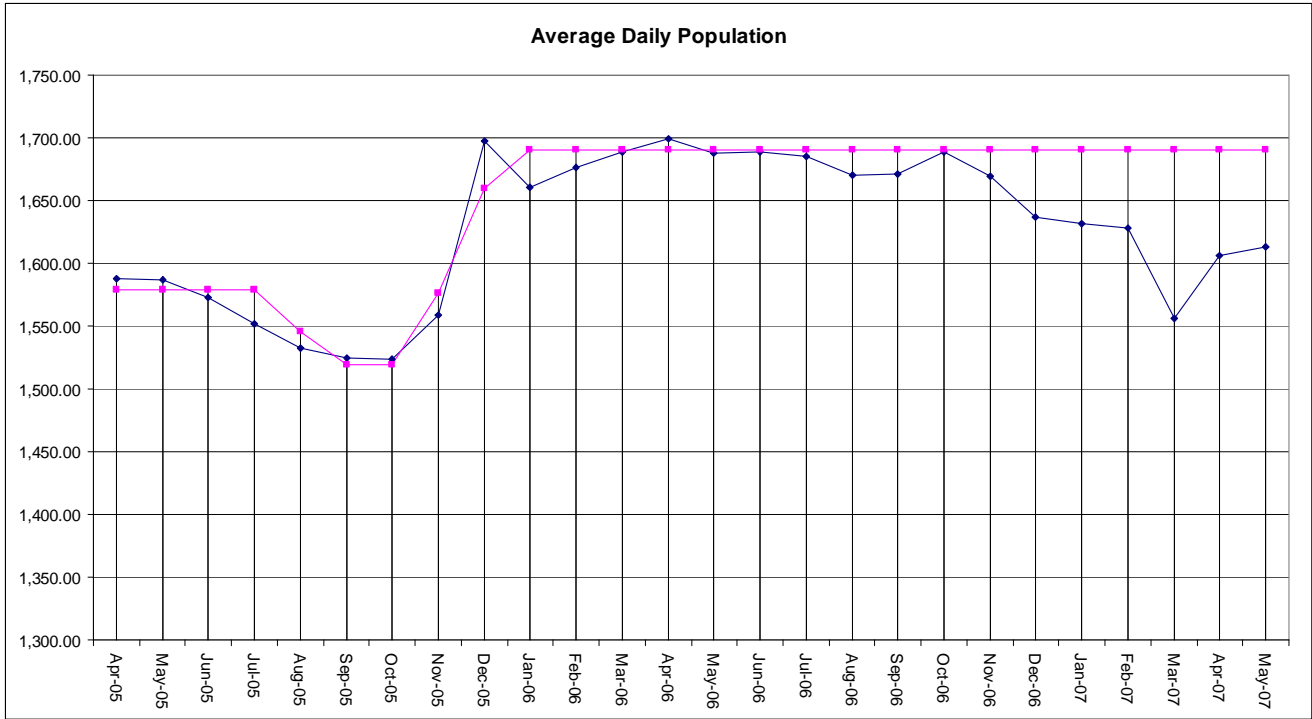


Cite & ID Bookings

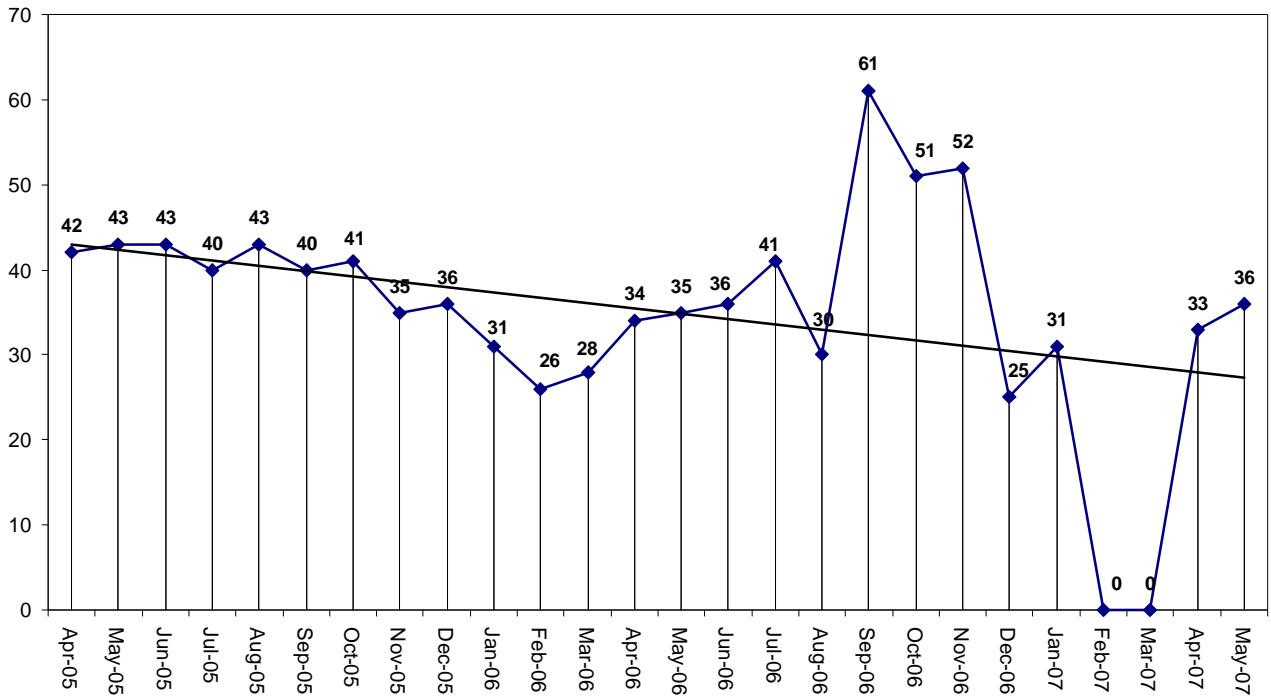


Average Length of Stay

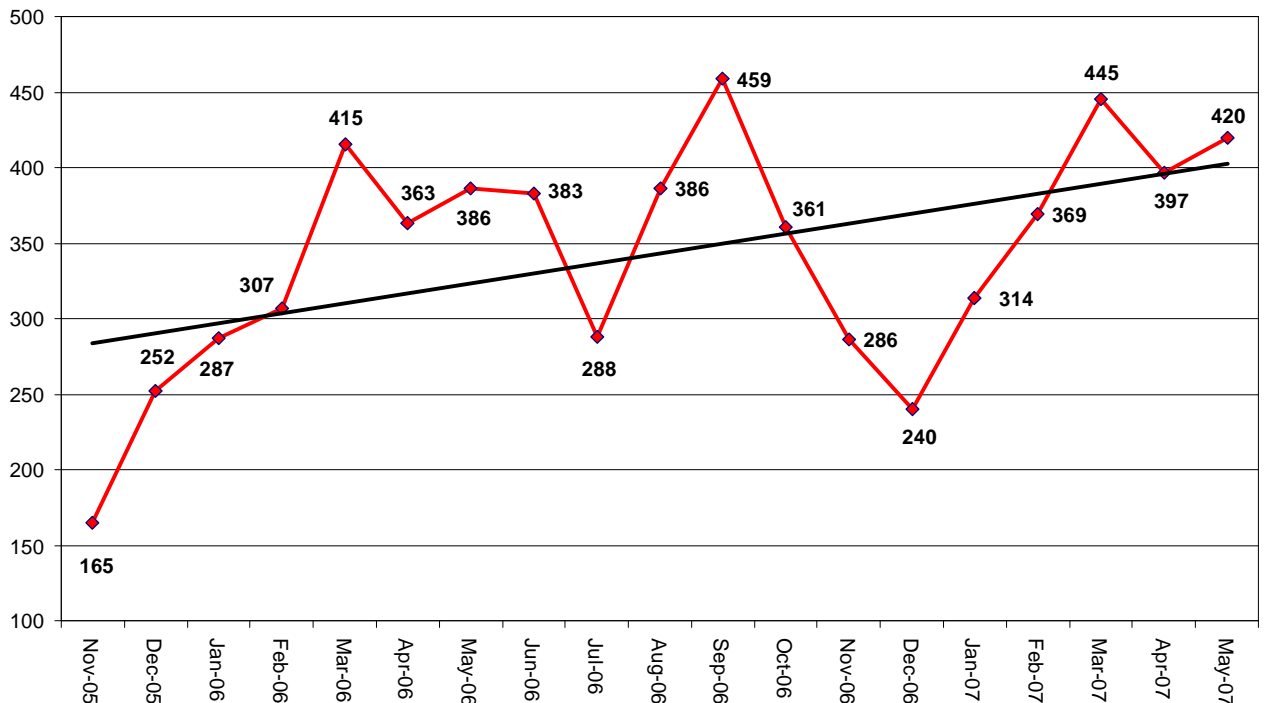




Monthly Average Score of Emergency Population Releases
