## Multnomah County Monthly Jail Statistics October 2007

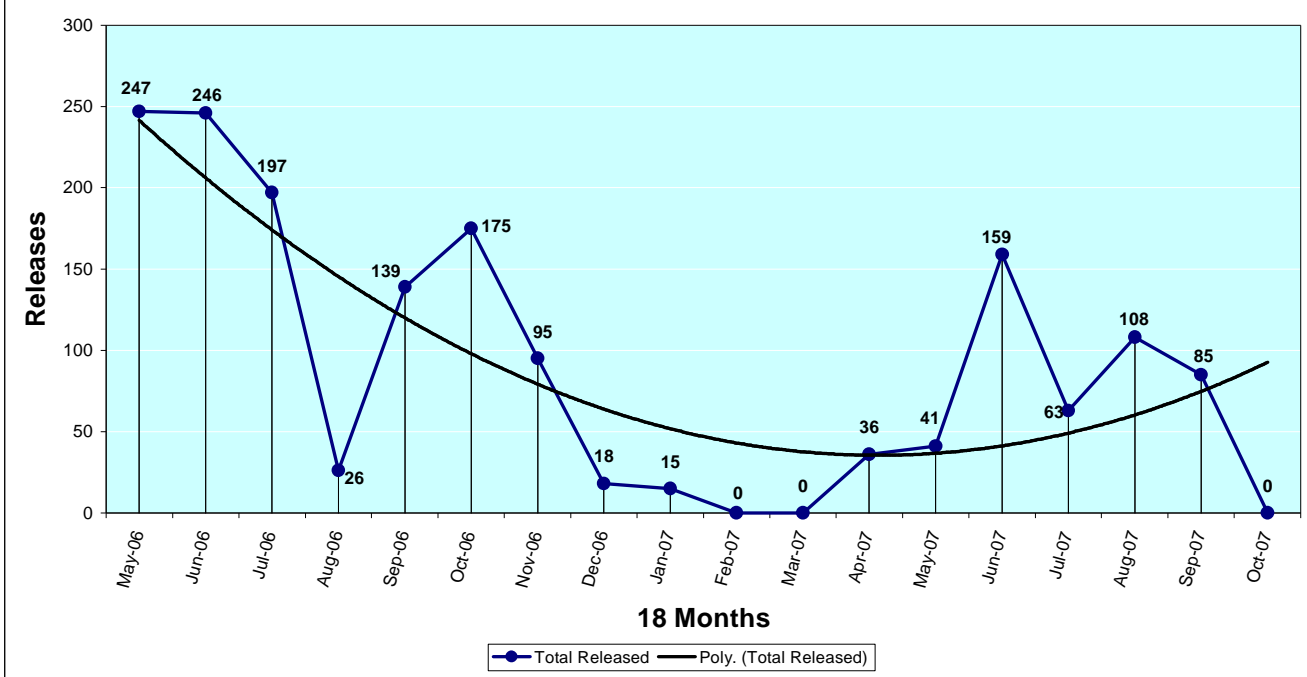
October ended with a total of 2,474 Standard Bookings; a 3.7% decrease from September's total of 2,570, and a 13% decrease over a year ago when October's Standard Bookings totaled 2,955. The 350 Cite & IDs during October were 12% less than September's total of 398 and 22.4% less than October of 2006 when they totaled 451. Turn Self In (TSI) bookings return an over 300 count during October; a 20% increase from September. The last time TSIs were over 300 was back in January and February of this year. For the past 5 months Average Length of Stay (ALS) has averaged 16.75 days. During October, ALS increased by 10.25%, averaging 18.66 days. The Average Daily Population slightly decreased by 3.74% from September's 1,612.24 average to October's 1,552.00 average. Jail Capacity was 1,633 beds during October and there were no Emergency Population Releases. Bookings for the Portland Project 57 totaled 299 for October; a decrease of 27.25% from September and 17.2% decrease from a year ago. Exclusive U.S. Marshall Prisoners averaged 125.3 for October.



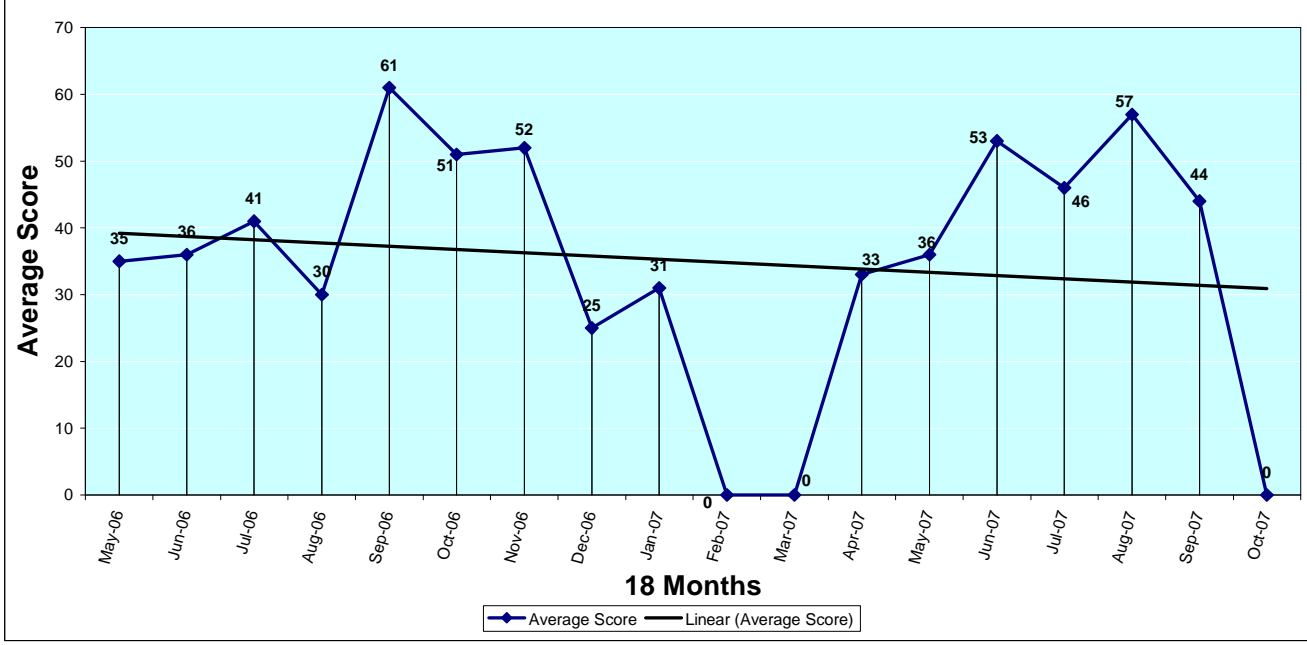




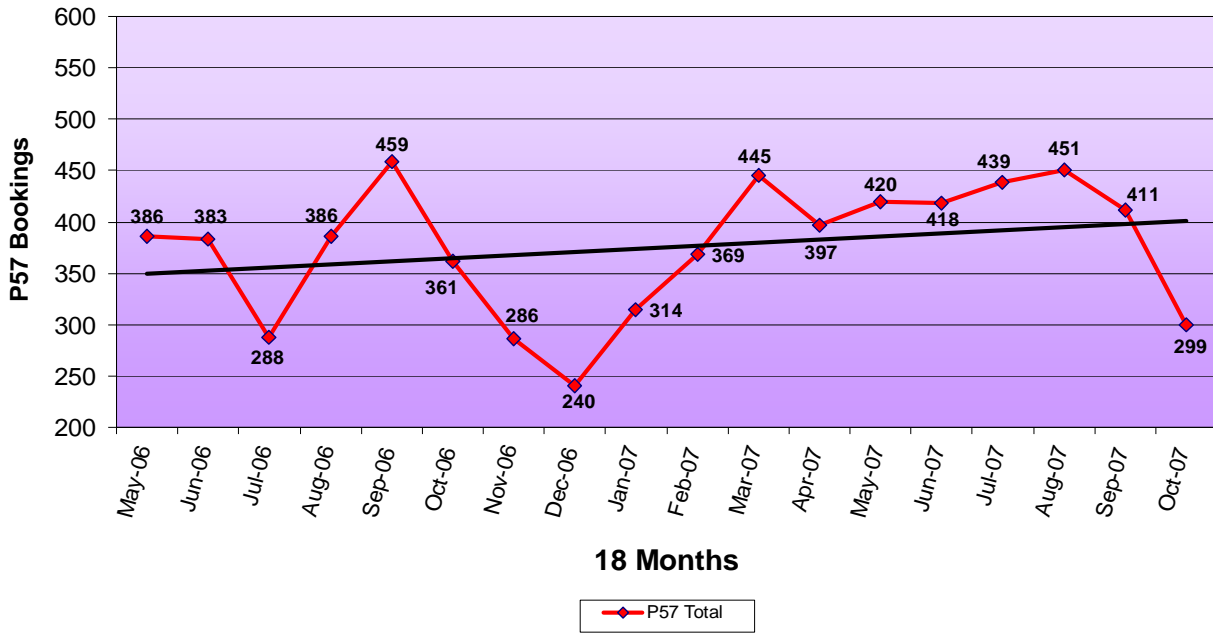
### Emergency Population Releases by Month



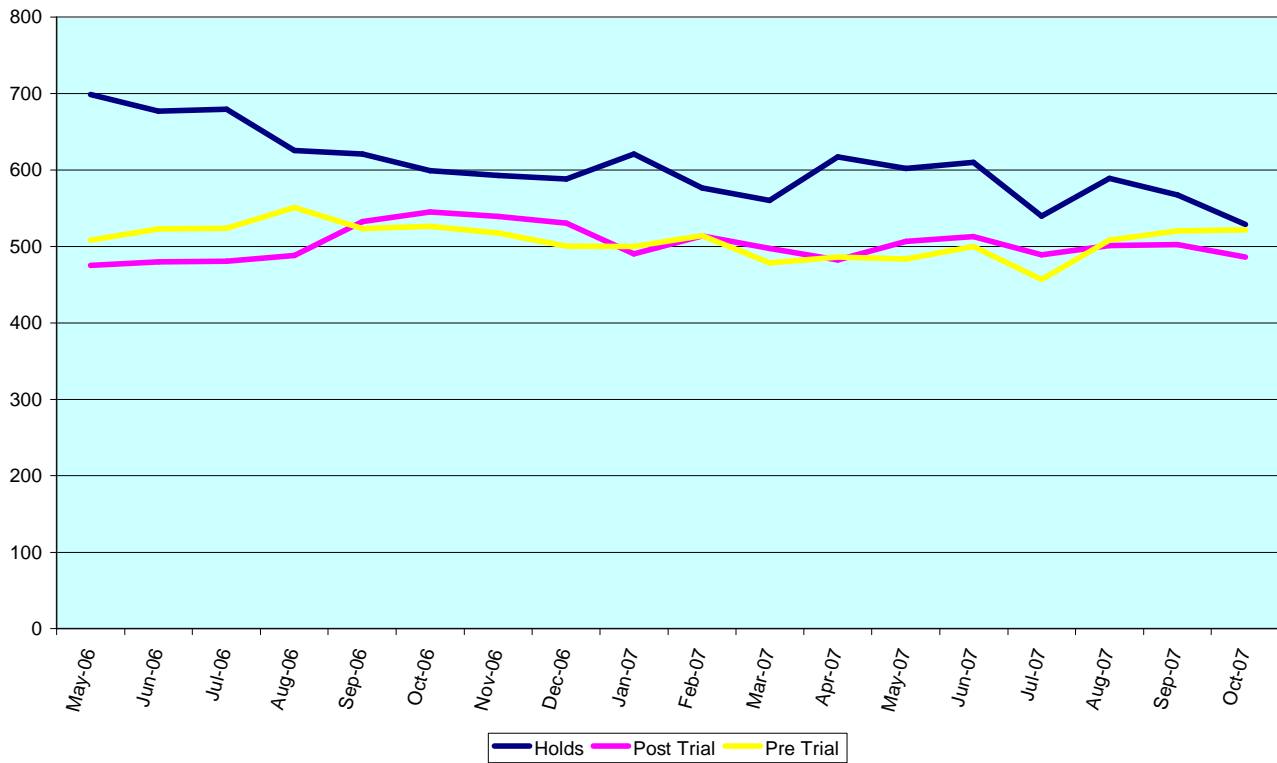
### Monthly Average Score of Emergency Population Releases



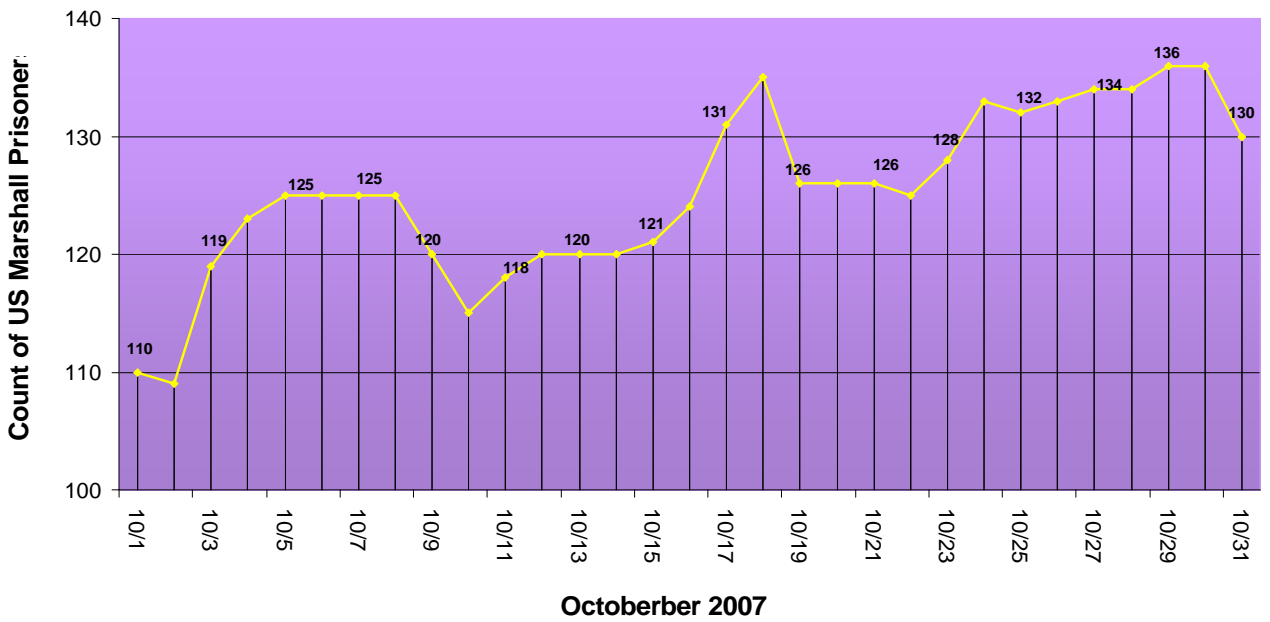
### Portland 57 Project - Total Bookings by Month



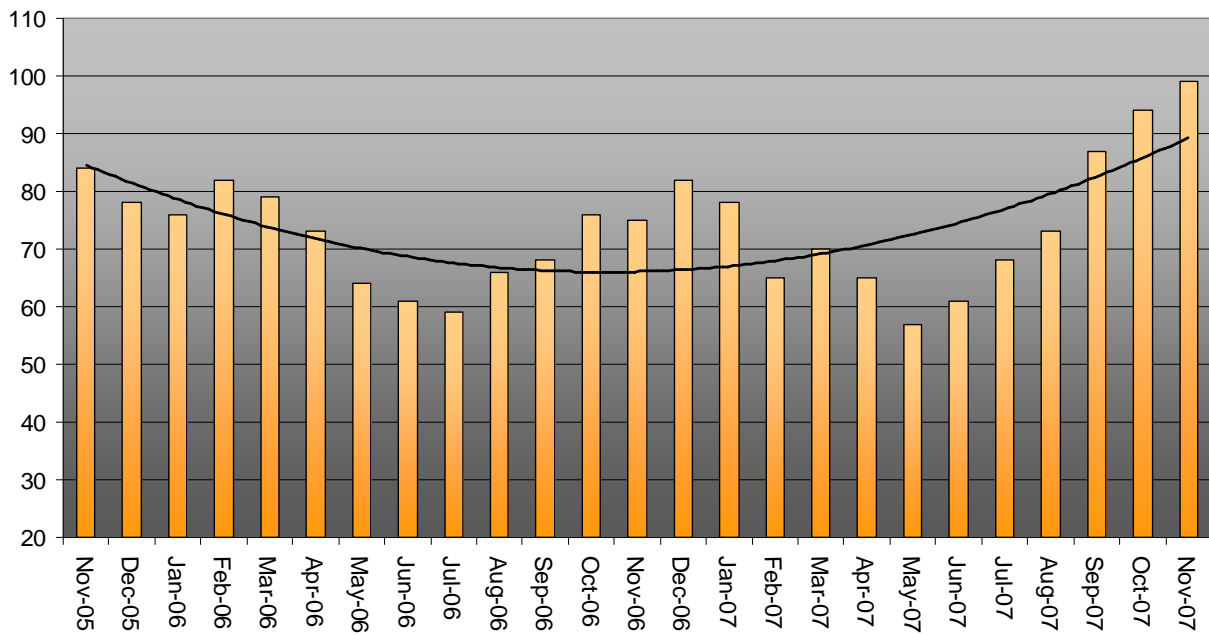
### Pre-Trial vs. Post-Trial vs. Holds in Custody



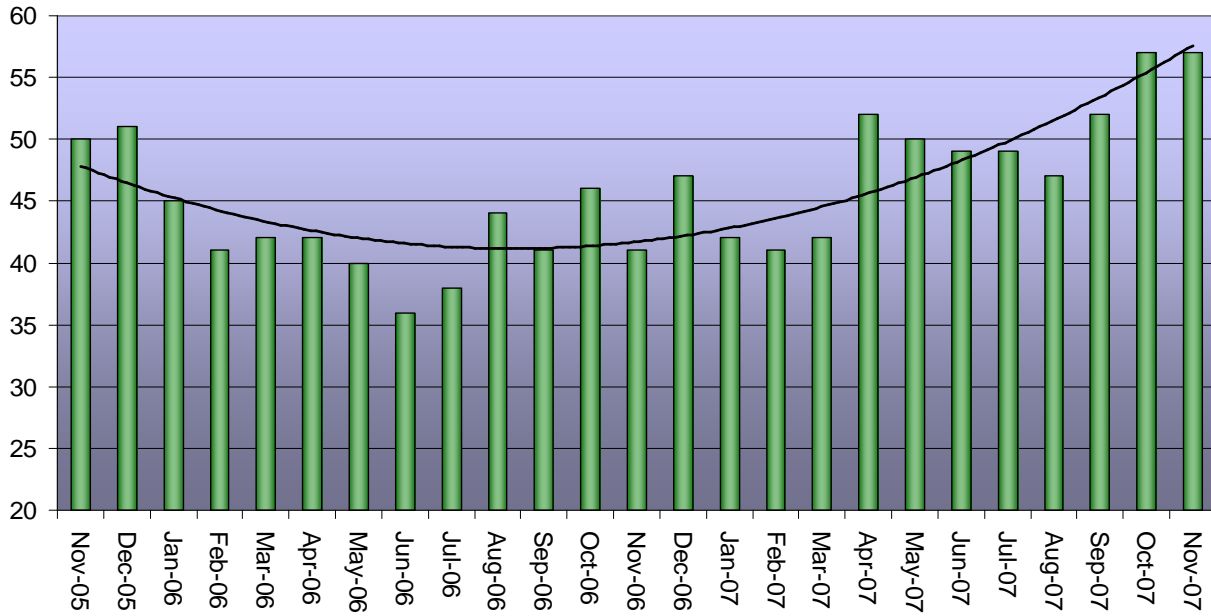
### August's Daily Count of Exclusive U.S. Marshall Prisoners
