**Multnomah County Monthly Jail Statistics
August 2007**

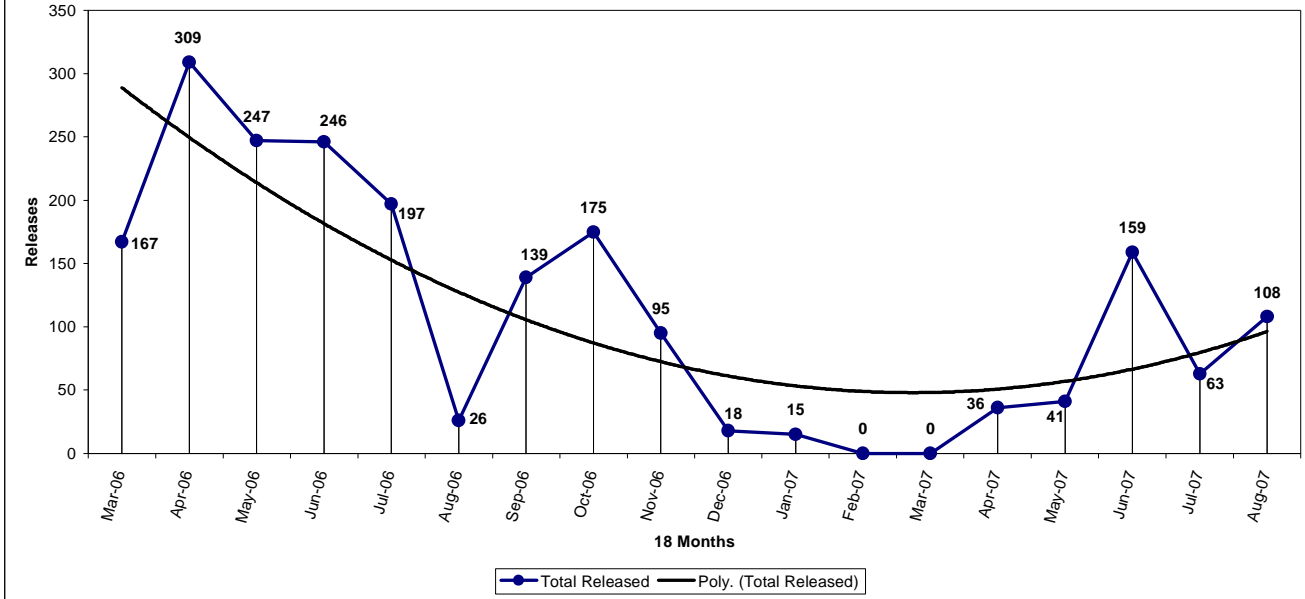
Standard Bookings totaled 2,953 for August which is a 6.4% increase from July and a 3.3% increase over last year's August total of 2,858 bookings. Cite & IDs remained the same as July totaling 386. This is slightly lower than a year ago when the total was 393 Cite & IDs for August. The Average Length of Stay (ALS) during August was 16.55 days; a slight drop from July's average of 16.79 days. The ALS one year ago was one day higher; averaging 17.76 days. The Average Daily Population (ADP) was 1,619.55 for August; less than 1% higher than July's average of 1,608.40 however this is 3% less than the ADP for August of 2006 which was 1,670.23. On July 1st, 2007 Jail Capacity was reduced for the fiscal year to 1,633. Emergency Population Releases occurred 6 times during August totaling 108 unsentenced individuals released early. This is a 41% increase from July's 63 early releases and a 76% increase over August 2006 when the total was down to 26 early releases for the month. The average score of those released early during August was 56; the highest score was 131. Portland Project 57 bookings totaled 451 for August; 12 more booking than July and 65 more bookings than August last year. The average number of exclusive U.S. Marshall Prisoners for August remained virtually the same as July's average of 143. Three charts have been added to this report; they represent 3 years of data covering Pre-Sentenced Holds.



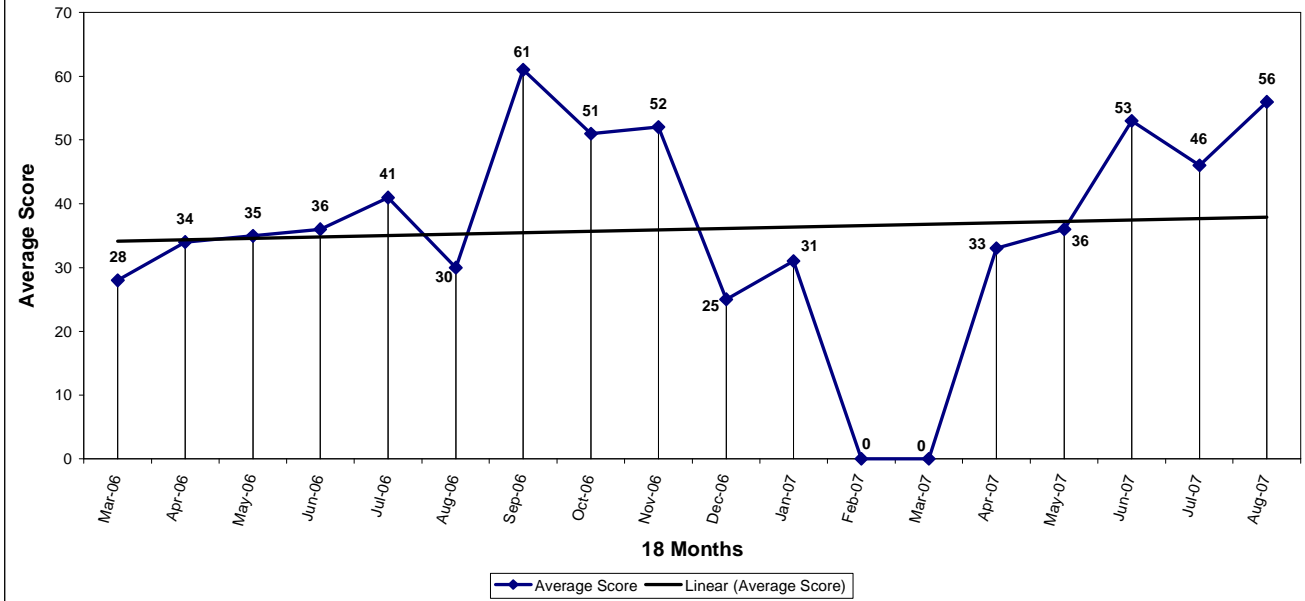




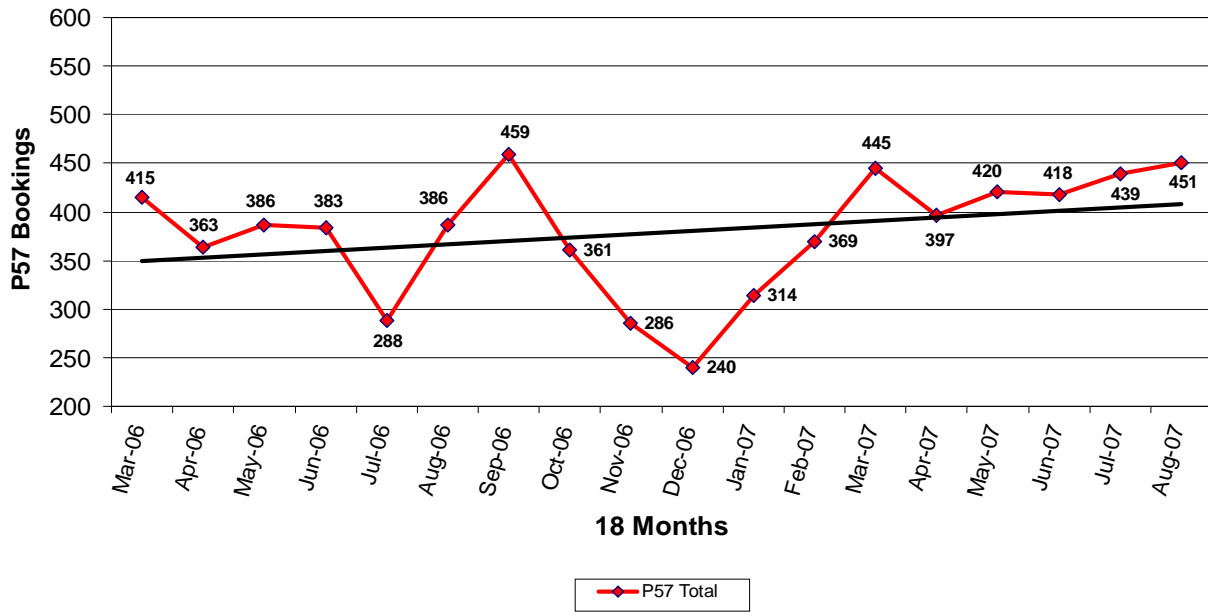
Emergency Population Releases by Month



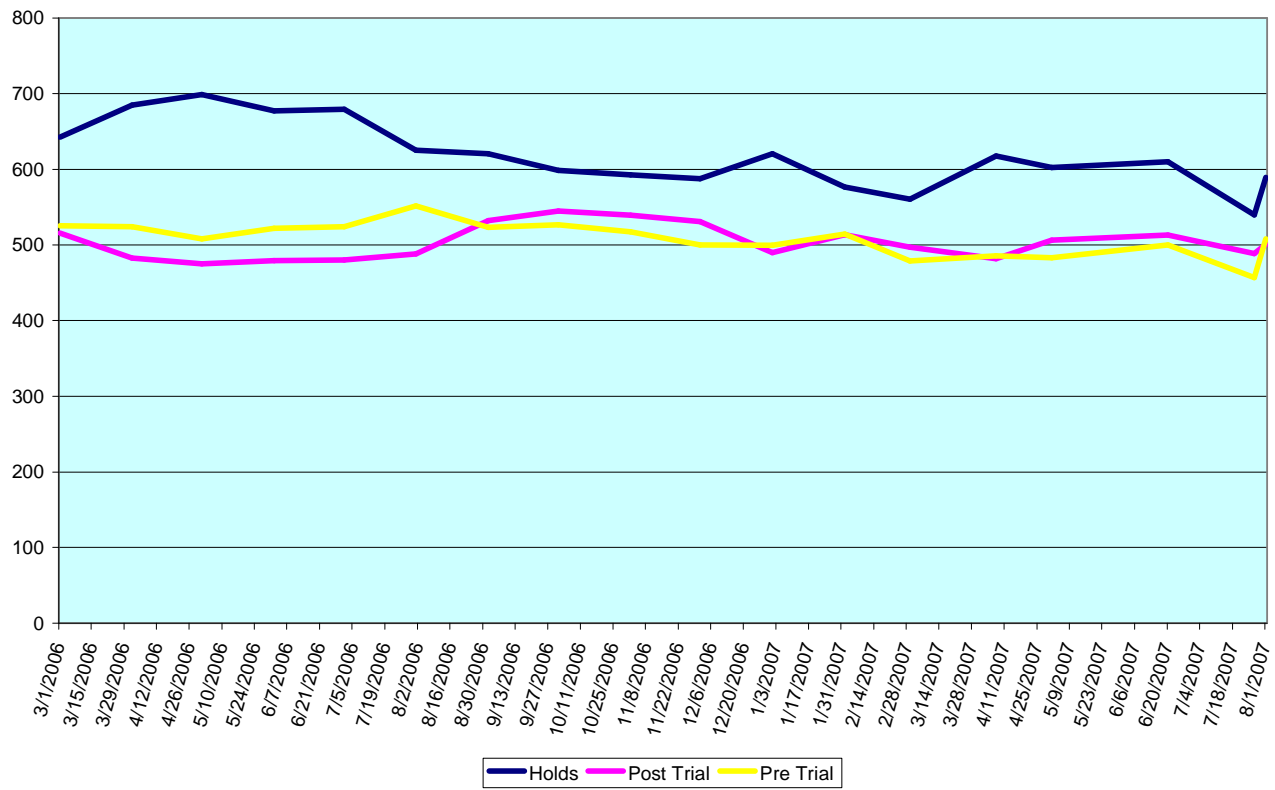
Monthly Average Score of Emergency Population Releases



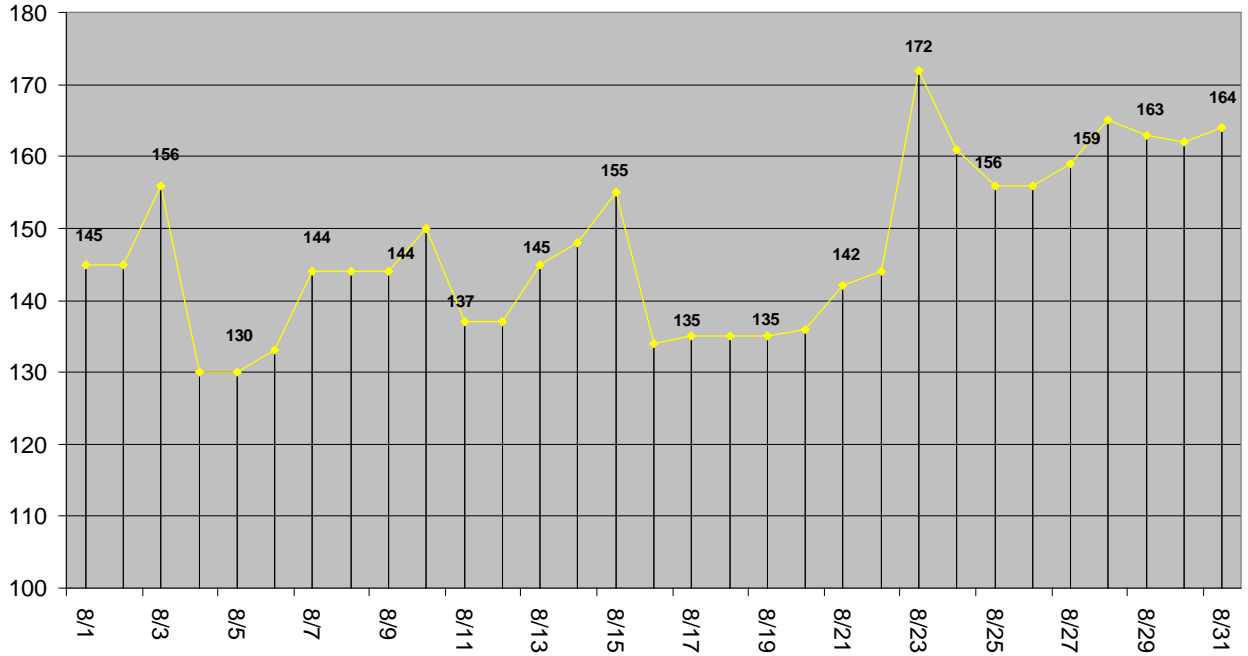
Portland 57 Project - Total Bookings by Month



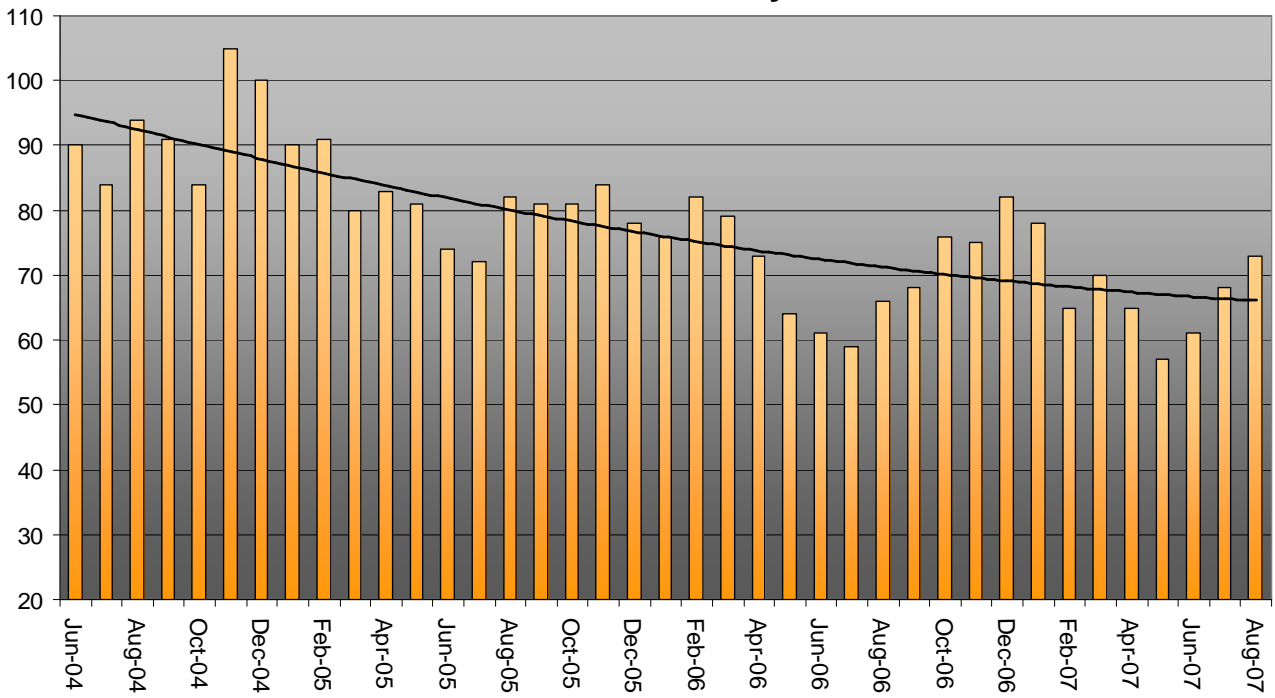
Pre-Trial vs. Post-Trial vs. Holds in Custody



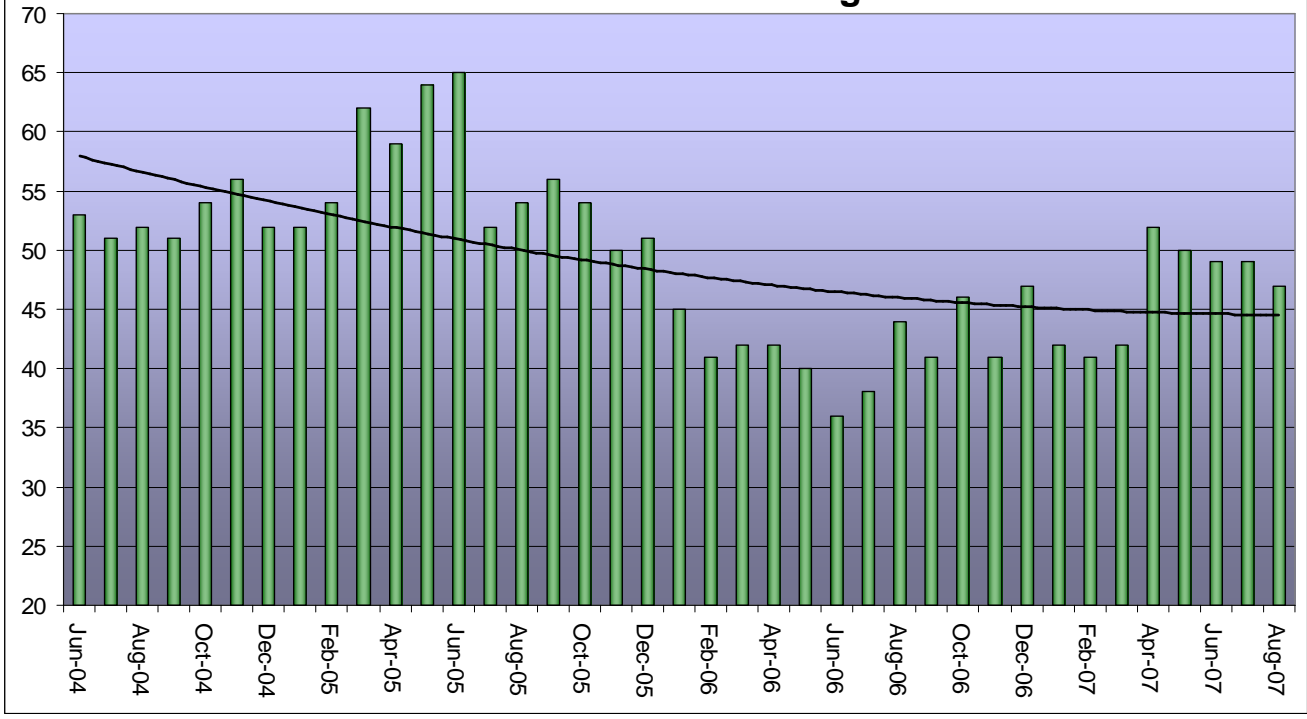
August's Daily Count of Exclusive U.S. Marshall Prisoners
